

Remarks on board bark *Vera* bound home from
Rio de Janeiro Humphrey Thuzman Master

Thursday Jan 14th 1841

First part of this day a fine breeze from N.W.
and slowly steaming E by N all sail set
latter part a fine breeze from N.W. Lat 48.10
Long 112.10

Friday Jan 15th 1841

First part of this day a fine breeze from N.W.
steaming E pleasant weather at 4 A.M. the
wind hauled to N.E. took in the studding
sails at 5 A.M. took the main top gallant
sail and double reefed the top sails rang
at 8 took in the top and main sail at 9
took in fore topsail to the part brisk gale
Lat Long

Saturday Jan 16th 1841

For part of this day brisk gale from N
and rang at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to N.W.
set the fore topsail double reefed steaming E
latter part steaming E by N all sail set at
11 A.M. got a lunar observation by measur-
ing the distance of the moon from the sun
Long by the Lunar 104.30 Long by Chron 105.15
Lat 48.10

Sunday Jan 17th 1841

First part of this day strong breeze from
N by N steaming E by N all sail set pleasant
weather middle part variable weather took
in the studding sails latter part pleasant
steaming E by N all sail set Lat 48.20 Long 101.37

Monday Jan 18th 1841

For part of this day strong breeze from N
steaming E by N at 4 A.M. the wind hauled
to N.W. latter part fresh gale and variable
weather at 8 A.M. took in the studding sails
No observation to Lat 48.40 Long 88.10

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Tuesday Jan 19th 1841

For part brisk to gale from N.W. and rang steaming
E by N at 4 P.M. West reefed the topsails at
6 P.M. the wind hauled sudden to N.W. took
in the fore topsail at 7 set the fore topsail
middle part fresh gale at 3 A.M. took in the
fore topsail and fore sail latter part strong gale
at 5 A.M. left to heading to N.W. under close
reefed main top sail rang Lat 50.15 Long 95.00

Wednesday Jan 20th 1841

For part strong gale at 1 P.M. moderated steady
of E at 2 set the fore sail at 4 set the fore
topsail double reefed brisk gale from N by E
at 10 P.M. the wind hauled to N.W. latter
part strong breeze and foggy steaming E by N
No observation to day Lat 50.18 Long 92.00

Thursday Jan 21th 1841

For part of this day strong breeze from N.W. by N
and foggy steaming E by N all sail set at 2 steaming
E at 7 P.M. brisk gale and foggy double reefed
the top sails at 3 A.M. moderated turned the
reefs out of the topsails at 9 made all sail
steaming E by N pleasant weather Lat 52.03 Long 87.27

Friday Jan 22th 1841

All this day a brisk breeze from N steaming
E by N variable weather at 4 A.M. steaming E by E
all sail set Lat 51.58 Long 84.41

Saturday Jan 23th 1841

For part brisk breeze from N steaming E by E
at 5 P.M. the wind hauled sudden to S.E. by E
took in the studding sails steaming by the
wind to Eastward variable weather at 6 wind
to S steaming E by E under double reefed topsails
at 11 P.M. wind hauled to S.W. by S latter part
the same pleasant weather Lat 52.48
Long 81.50
