

Remarks on board Bark *Cora* bound home
Humphrey Wharman Master

Monday Feb 15th 1841

Fore part of this day brisk breeze from N.W.
boats of *Thasin* Whales at 3 P.M. com on
board saw nine Whales load but without
success at sunset com on board sharing
by the wind to E.N.E at 11 P.M. were ship
to W.S.W. strong breeze at 6 A.M. saw several
Spum Whales toward the boats at 10. Wash
boat ship and got stove. Rotten boat stuck
and hiled Lat 41.04 Long 50.40



Tuesday Feb 16th 1841

Fore part strong breeze from N.W. and pleasant
weather at 4 P.M. took the Whale along side
to urge to cut. Middle and latter part strong
breeze at 5 A.M. were ship and commenced
cutting Lat 41.25 Long 51.00

Wednesday Feb 17th 1841

Fore part strong breeze from N.W. and pleasant
weather employed in cutting at 7 P.M. finish
cutting Middle and latter part fresh gale
steering by the wind to N.E. under Fore sail
and lost rufed. Main top sail Lat 41.23

Thursday Feb 18th 1841

Fore part fresh gale from N.W. by W. and pleasant
steering by the wind to N.E. at 11 P.M. took in
the fore sail latter part fresh gale Lat 40.49

Friday Feb 19th 1841

Fore part fresh gale from N.W. at 1 P.M. the
wind hauled to W. and ran at 5 P.M. pleasant
weather commenced boiling latter part strong
breeze from S. steering N.W. at 9 A.M. steering
N.W. employed in boiling Lat 39.26
Long 49.46

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Saturday Feb 20th 1841

Fore part strong breeze from S. steering N.W.
at 1 A.M. the wind hauled to S. latter part light
breeze and calm pleasant weather employed
in boiling Lat 39.02

Sunday Feb 21st 1841

Fore part light breeze from S. steering by the
wind to E.N.E at 3 P.M. finish boiling firm
pleasant weather latter part strong breeze saw
2 ships employed in coquina Lat 39.00 Long

Monday Feb 22nd 1841

Fore part strong breeze from S. steering by the wind
to E.N.E at 4 P.M. spoke the *Minerva* of New Bedford
1200 lbs 400 spum latter part light breeze
Lat 39.23 Long 47.00

Tuesday Feb 23rd 1841

Fore part light breeze from S. steering S. spoke
the concide of *Lagharbour* 3 months out no oil
at 4 P.M. wind hauled to E by S. steering N.W. &
pleasant weather latter part brisk breeze at 7 P.M.
took in the waste boat to murel tools to day

Wednesday Feb 24th 1841

Fore part light breeze from E by S to S. steering by the
wind to S. and N.W. variable weather at 12
wind hauled to N.W. were ship to S.W. latter part
strong breeze Lat 37.51 Long 48.12

Thursday Feb 25th 1841

Fore part brisk gale from W. steering S. under close
ruff top sail. Middle and latter part strong
breeze from S.W. steering S. Lat 35.30 Long 47.00.21
