

Bark. Cora. November. 1841.

61. Monday November 1st 1841. Commences with light breezes and variable heading from S by W. to W. S. W. Several bays and bays in sight Middle and Latter part the same with rain one man sick
Moon Lat 7. 31. N Long 23 21 W

62. Tuesday Nov 2nd. Commences with pleasant breezes from the South headed to the E. S. E. employed setting up the Fore rigging and other jobs Middle part equally with rain Latter part moderate with rain several sails in sight
Moon Lat 7. 09 N Long 21 28 W

63. Wednesday Nov 3rd. Commences with pleasant breezes from E. S. E. steering to the South Middle part light airs from West with heavy rain. Latter part light breeze from E. N. E. steering S. by E. employed breaking out for boats. Then Carpenter badly ruptured
Moon Lat 6. 09 N Long 21 50 W

64. Thursday Nov 4th. Commences light airs from the East employed setting up the Starboard side of the Fore rigging and Footstays several sails in sight Middle and Latter part light breezes from S. E. to S. W. employed in ships duty. 2 men sick
Moon Lat 5. 31 N Long 21 05 W

65. Friday Nov 5th. Commences with light breezes from S. E. heading S. W. by the Wind employed setting up the Starboard side of the Main rigging & 2 p. M. spoke the Ship. Ann. of New Bedford. 38 days out now Middle part light airs and variable with rain Latter part the same. so ends with 2 men sick
Moon Lat 4. 30 N Long 20 58 W

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66. Saturday Nov 6th 1841. Commences with light airs from S. E. heading by the Wind to S. W. employed setting up the Starboard side of the Main rigging Middle and Latter part light airs and variable with rain
Moon Lat 4. 52 N Long 21 50 W

67. Sunday Nov 7th. Commences with light airs and calm with rain several sails in sight Middle and Latter part light airs from S. E. heading by the Wind to S. W. with rain and distant Thunder so ends with Carpenter and Richardson sick
Moon Lat 4. 30 N Long 22 10 W

68. Monday Nov 8th. Commences with light airs and calm with rain several sails in sight Middle and Latter part light breezes from S. E. to S. W. and pleasant employed in ships duty. so ends 2 men sick
Moon Lat 4. 20 N Long 21 47 W

69. Tuesday Nov 9th. Commences with light airs and variable heading from S. by W. to S. W. Middle and Latter part the same with passing rain squalls 4 sails in sight
Moon Lat 4. 14 N Long 21 34 W

70. Wednesday Nov 10th. Commences with Calm and pleasant it is tremendous hard work for the barge Cora to get along Long @ 2 p. M. for Lunar Obs. 21. 33 W. Obs. 21 40 W. Middle and Latter part light breezes from S. E. to E. S. E. employed in ships duty.
