

135. Friday Jan. 14th 1842. Commenced with Strong Gale from N.W. to N.E. took in the Fore sail @ 8 P.M. saw a Ship to Windward heading to N.E. under Close reef. Fore and Main top sails Middle and Latter part Strong gale from N.W. with passing rain and hail squalls heading from S.W. to S.E.

Noon Lat 58-50. S. Long 74-10 W.

136. Saturday Jan. 15th. All these 24 hours Strong gale from N.W. to S.W. and squally with a heavy sea running heading from S.W. to S.E.

Noon Lat 58-20 S. Long 76-30 W.

137. Sunday Jan. 16th. Commenced the same @ 4 P.M. wore Ship to the N.W. Middle part the same the wind from the S.W. at 6 A.M. set the Fore sail. Latter part light off N.W. to the Fore top sail close reef Main sail and turned one reef out of the Main top sails Strong breeze from S. with passing snow squalls.

Noon Lat 58-40 S. Long 74-50 W.

138. Monday Jan. 17th. Commenced with Strong breeze from S. with passing snow squalls steering N.W. Middle part Moderate breeze from S.W. heading N.W. by the Wind with Fog. Latter part made all sail heading from N.W. to N.E.

Noon Lat 56-48 S. Long 76-45 W.

139. Tuesday Jan. 18th. Fresh breeze from N.W. and hazy took in the Main top gallant sail @ 4 P.M. tacked to the S.W. and double reefed the Top sail @ 5 P.M. Strong breeze with rain fresh the S.W. and Main sail Middle part the same Latter part set the S.W. and Main sail

Lat 56-53 S. Long 77-10 W.

140. Wednesday Jan. 19th. Commenced with Fresh breeze from N.W. to W. with rain @ 5 P.M. took in the S.W. Main sail and Fore top sail heading S.W. Middle part the same day light set the Fore top sail Latter Moderate set the Main sail and S.W. sounds 2 Muskets

Noon Lat 57-33 S. Long 78-14 W.

141. Thursday Jan. 20th. Commenced with Fresh breeze from N.W. to N.E. heading S.W. @ 8 P.M. turned one reef out of the Main top sail and set the Main top gallant sail. Middle part the same heading from S.W. to S.E. day light Fresh breeze took in the Main top gallant sail Latter part double reef the Main top sail. Sounded.

Noon Lat 58-00 S. Long 79-50 W.

142. Friday Jan. 21st. Commenced with Fresh breeze and Fog with rain heading from S.W. to N.W. @ 5 took in the S.W. La Middle part Fresh breeze from N.W. with passing rain squalls took in the Main sail @ 7 A.M. wore ship to N.W. Close reef the Fore top sail and set the S.W. and Main sail Sounded with passing squalls.

Noon 58-24 S. Long 80-40 W.

143. Saturday Jan. 22nd. Fresh breeze from West heading N.W. by the Wind. Middle part the same heading N.W. by the N. Latter part Moderate turned one reef out of the Fore and Main top sail and set the Main top gallant sail heading N. tacked to the S.W. saw a frigate Sounded with 2 Muskets

Noon Lat 57-06 S. Long 80-16 W.
