E. day light Am broke and St. Felix in sight 11 A.M. boarded the Eagle noon left the Eagle for Shore a fishing.

161. Wednesday Feb 9th Commenced with Light breezes from E. S. E. Under the Boat returned with great amount of Fish also, killed a large Sea Seal. Sunset St. Felix bore S. by W. dist 7 miles. braced forward to N. E. by the Union Middle and latter Light breezes. The Eagle in the morning employed in ship's duty.

162. Thursday Feb 10th Commenced with Light breezes from E. S. E. and pleasant steering by the Wind to N. E. the ship Eagle on the Weather bow employed hauling the Sea Lion and Spanker.
 Noon Lat^o 34-40 S. Long 78-30 W.

163. Friday Feb 11th Commenced with Light airs and pleasant mending the Spanker Middle Part fresh breezes from S. E. Steering N. E. day light saw the Ship Eagle on the Weather bow amongst Whales & 11 A.M. saw the Whale lowerd the boats.

164. Saturday Feb 12th 1842. Light breezes from S. E. boats of after the Whale. The Eagle's Boats struck the Whale and killed him & 2 p.m. came on board and braced forward to the N. E. employed mending the Mainsail saw Blackfish sunset took in sail day light made all sail steering to N. E. untent the Mainsail and beat the second one & mended the Mainsail.

165. Sunday Feb 13th Commenced with Light breezes from S. E. Steering N. E. employed mending the Fore sail sunset took in sail day light made sail steering to N. E. hands at leisure mended one Mainsail.

166. Monday Feb 14th Commenced with Light breezes from S. E. Steering to N. E. & 2 p.m. saw a shoal of sperm Whales lowerd the Boats succeeded in taking one.  The Larboard Boat got tightly stove & sunset got the Whale along side and took in sail day light commenced cutting & 8. finish^d made sail heading to N. E. took in the fore Boat and commenced mending her.
 noon Lat^o 21-29 S. Long 74-20 W.

167. Tuesday Feb 15th Light breezes from S. E. steering N. E. employed mending the Boat and cutting up the blubber sunset took in sail day light made sail and commenced boiling finish^d the Boat and put her out at 9 A.M. saw Blackfish lowerd 2 Boats got one. hands steering N. E.
