

230. Tuesday April 19th Light breeze and pleasant.
8 Men on shore cutting wood 7 Men after Teripin
The Kingston of Antigua came to anchor and the
Marcus of Fairhaven below

231. Wednesday 20th Employed getting off board & 10 b. h.
The boat returned with 8 Large Teripin & 3 A.M. 3 Boats
left after Teripin

232. Thursday 21st Light breeze and pleasant & 9 p.m.
The Harbour boat returned with 7 Teripin Employed
getting wood.

233. Friday 22nd Getting off board and getting ready to get
under way & 5 p.m. got under way to come down
& 11 A.M. came to anchor in 12 fathoms rocky bottom
Mr. Lewis sick with the Fever Ague the Ship Orion
of Antigua came to anchor

234. Saturday 23rd Pleasant weather & 2 p.m. the 2 Boats
returned with 12 Teripin Mr. Lewis rather better
& 3 A.M. 3 boats left the Ship after Teripin in company
with the Orion's boats.

235. Sunday 24th Pleasant weather & 6 p.m. strong
breeze from N.W. 3 Boats after Teripin

236. Monday 25th Strong breeze from N.W. & 10 A.M.
Moderating, & 7 p.m. on Boat returned with 30 cow
Teripin. Saw for provisions & 3 A.M. the Boat left
for more. Sailed with Calm.

237. Tuesday 26th Commenced with Calm and light air
3 Boats after Teripin & 6 p.m. the Boats returned with
70 Teripin & 7 A.M. 2 Boats left loading

238. Wednesday 27th Light air and calm & 5 p.m. took
on board 2 Boat load of board. & 7 A.M. 2 Boats leaving
Employed on Board stowing wood

239. Thursday 28th Light breeze from N.W. & 2 p.m.
got aboard with 2 Boat load of board stowing wood
and other Jobs found

240. Friday 29th Light breeze and calm. Stowing
Wood and other Jobs. & 8 A.M. took our anchor and
sailed to sea in search of Sperm Whales

241. Saturday 30th Commenced with Light breeze
and variable heading from N.E. to N.W. Middle
part the Light breeze latter part Light breeze from
E. steering N.W. Employed in ship's duty.
Now Lat 11° 14' N. Long 89° 30' W.

242. Sunday May 1st 1842
Commenced with Light breeze from E.N.E.
steering N.W. saw Black fish towards one
Boat for Black fish without success Middle
part Light air from E.N.E. steering N.W. latter part
the same. & 7 A.M. saw Abington Island to N.E.
Now Lat 11° 23' N. Long 91° 10' W.
