daylight the Land in sight. Latter part calm.

254. Friday 13<sup>th</sup> Commenced with light air and variable  
heading to the S. 2 Ships in sight started Rodondo Rock  
bore S.W. 1/2 E. with 5 miles. Middle and Latter part calm  
and foggy.
