322 Wednesday July 20th All these 24 hours Fresh breeze.
S.E. by S. heading to the S.E. Humpbacks in sight.
Noon Lat 3° 50' N. Long 87° 45' W.

323 Thursday July 21st All these 24 hours Fresh breeze
from S.E. by S. heading by the S.E. nothing in sight.
Mr. Lewis Sick
Noon Lat 5° 55' N. Long 86° 40' W.

324 Friday July 22nd All these 24 hours Fresh breeze & S.
heading E.S.E. by the wind nothing in sight Mr. Lewis Sick
Noon Lat 7° 54' N. Long 85° 40' W.

325 Saturday July 23rd All these 24 hours strong breeze & S.
heading by the wind to E.S.E. Mr. Lewis no better.
Noon Lat 10° 16' N. Long 84° 30' W.

326 Sunday July 24th All these 24 hours Moderate breeze
and Cloudy heading to the E.S. by the wind no Whales to be
seen. Mr. Lewis no better.
Lat by Acc 39.46 S. Long 83° 10' W.

327 Monday July 25th 1842 All these 24 hours Moderate breeze from
E.S.E. to S.E. by S. heading by the wind from E.S.E. to S.E. Plenty of
Albacore and Bonitos round the Ship. Mr. Lewis no better.
Noon Lat 11° 15' S. Long 82° 00' W.

328 Tuesday July 26th Moderate trades and cloudy heading to the E.S.
by the wind one sail in sight daylight saw the Isles of La Plata off
one E by N. tack ship to the W. Capt. a Sloop heading in shore & 10 tack
in shore, sound all well except Mr. Lewis
Noon Lat 12° 10' S. Long -

329 Wednesday July 27th Moderate trades heading in shore 2 P.M.
saw the Sloop & 4 P.M. saw 1 blackfish toward 3 boats got one.
saw 10 heads of those the Land in sight daylight heading in for
the Land latter part employ 1 blackfish Mr. Lewis still
Sick -
Noon Lat 13° 35' S.

330 Thursday July 28th Moderate and cloudy employ 1 blackfish
took 5. Hunted tack in shore & 9 tack of those 3. A N. tack in shore
daylight saw the Land to the N.E. heading S.E. blackfish in
sight Mr. Lewis no better.
Noon Lat 15° 00' S. Long 81° 53' W.

331 Friday July 29th Moderate and pleasant beating up
along shore to Paita to land Mr. Lewis employ 2 boiling out
the blackfish the Land and a schooner in sight
Noon Lat 16° 31' S.

332 Saturday July 30th Moderate trades heading in to the S.E.
for the Land sunset heading off shore to the W. daylight heading
in shore to S.E. the Land in sight also a Sloop steering to the North
blackfish and Humpbacks.
Noon Lat 18° 46' S. Long 81° 05' W.
