Sunday Oct 7th Commenced with Light breezes & S.W. steering to the N.E. & S.W. haul by the wind to N.W. with the Head Yard to the North daylight saw 5 Ships to Anchor & 2 Ships came to Anchor in 4 fathoms water to the N. of the Bar. Employed getting Casks ready for water Ships to Anchor & Bomber, Lafatte, Emily, Morgan of N.B. Marzanich of Nant. Boy of Warren. Geo. Washington of Wareham and Aurora of Nant.

402. Saturday Oct 8th Commenced with Light breezes & N.W. took the raft up the river to file one Boat. Crew cutting wood. Sunset got off 2 Boat loads of wood. The Habins of Nant and N.P. Talman of Gloucester came to anchor.

403. Sunday Oct 9th All this day Light breezes and pleasant hands at leisure on this the Lord's day except one watch on Liberty Hunted the Liberty Men on board some pretty Wrenks.

404. Monday Oct 10th Employed this day getting of water wood off to the Barque. Later Part flowing water and got a raft of Casks up the river to file.

405. Tuesday Oct 11th Employed filling water and cutting wood. and getting off Potatoes discharged appeared 2 Ships came to Anchor.

406. Wednesday Oct 12th Employed getting off wood water Potatoes and flowing.

407. Thursday Oct 13th Employed. Wooding and flowing water discharged James Cook.

408. Friday Oct 14th Employed getting of wood. took a raft of casks up the river to file discharged one Spanish.

409. Saturday Oct 15th Employed getting of wood water and potatoes discharged Sam Smith & Black.

410. Sunday Oct 16th Employed flowing water and wood and getting ready for sea.

411. Monday Oct 17th Light breezes & N.W. & 2 P.M. Heigh Anchor for Paita left 10 Ship to Anchor Middle Part beating up along shore Later part the same Noon Lat 33-38 S.

412. Tuesday Oct 18th All these 24 hours beating up along shore a breeze and a breeze in night Noon Lat 33-50 S.

413. Wednesday Oct 19th All these 24 hours Fresh breeze beating to windward sunset Cape Blanco bore S.W. by E. daylight Cape Blanco bore E by N. Noon Lat 43-30 S.

414. Thursday Oct 20th All these 24 hours Fresh breeze heading E.S.E. past the Steam Boat sunset Payta Head bore S.E. by E. daylight Payta Head bore S. by E. N. came to anchor in the Harbour of Payta 6 fathoms water the Bark Desdemona of N.B. 38 Month 900 lbs.

415. Friday Oct 21th Employed painting ship the watch on Liberty discharged 2 Men.

416. Saturday Oct 22th Employed painting ship watch on Liberty.

417. Sunday Oct 23th At Leisure the watch on Liberty.

418. Monday Oct 24th Employed painting the watch on Liberty the Steam Boat came to Anchor.
