

Thursday 19th From today till Sunday I have been sick
and not able to write up the first day but we
made pleasant weather the second day heavy rough
weather Lat^o 34 25 S. Long 75 52 W. Saturday 21st
all the 24 hours light breezes and calm with a heavy
swell from S.W. Lat^o 37 59 S. Long 75 36 W.

Friday Dec 22nd Commenced with light air and calm
heading from S.W. to N.W. Middy part the same
Later part light breeze (N.W.) till foretopmast the sail
and chain of top gallant stand still
Moon Lat^o 38 19 S. Long 76 10 W.

Saturday Dec 23rd Commenced with light breezes
and pleasant heading S.W. to S.E. Middy
and later part the same to end with 2 Middy
sick - Moon Lat^o 39 18 S. Long 76 19 W.

Sunday Dec 24th Commenced with light breezes
and variable heading from S.W. to S.E. Middy
and later part calm. Moon Lat^o 40 00 S. Long 76 00 W.

Monday Dec 25th Commenced with light breezes (N.W.)
heading S.W. to S.E. Middy. Saw the South Head of Valdivia
bearing by compass E by N. 10 miles from the Chro. 40 miles
to the West (S.W.) out. Tacked to the Westward Middy and
later part the same to end. Moon Lat^o 41 14 S. Long 76 10 W.
by Chro. Lat^o 41 14 S. Long 76 22 W.

Tuesday Dec 26th Commenced with pleasant breeze
and fine weather heading to the West Later part
steering to S.W. by S. under all sail standing sail
Moon Lat^o 40 01 S. Long 76 40 W.
Time Long 77 20 W.

Wednesday Dec 27th Commenced with light breezes from
the North and pleasant Middy part haul^o more to the
Westward took in the top gallant the standing sails Later
part haul^o to N.W. took foretopmast the sail, strong
breezes single reef the top sails heading S.W. by the
Wind. Moon Lat^o 41 35 S. Long 78 49 W. 3 p.m.

Thursday Dec 28th Commenced with light strong breezes
from W. to S.W. steering S.W. Middy part the same
Later part squally made sail one of the passengers children
very sick. steering South. Moon Lat^o 42 14 S. Long 79 40 W.

Friday Dec 29th Commenced with strong breezes and
squally steering S. to S.W. The Infant son of Widow Scott that
lost her husband on the Passage from Valparaiso to Salcedo
died of the Dysentery (S.W.) committed his body to the deep
aged 18 months. Middy part fresh breezes (S.W.) Later part
more moderate with the stand sails steering to the South.
Moon Lat^o 45 19 S. Long 80 03 E 3 p.m.

Saturday Dec 30th Commenced with fresh breezes (N.W.) steering
S. under all sail Middy part squally took in the stand sail
wind haul^o to N.W. Later part the same with rain squalls
Moon Lat^o 46 58 S. Long 80 10 W.

Sunday Dec 31st Commenced with fresh breezes (from
W. to S.W.) steering S.W. Middy part the same Later
part took the stand sails. Caught 3 Porpoises skins
Moon Lat^o 48 57 S. Long 80 10 West
