5 Saturday 9th Come with light wind from the N. steering E. S. E. by compass fine weather the watch employed in various parts Middle part the same Latter part fine wind from the N. N. steering E. S. E. the watch employed in various parts Lat 38.59 Long 63.04

6 Sunday 10th Come with fine breeze from N. N. steering E. S. E. by compass Middle part light Gale from the N. N. and fine weather Latter part light Gale from the N. Lat 38.12 Caught a Popfish

7 Monday 11th Come with fresh Gale from the N. steering E. S. E. and fine weather Middle part Latter part fresh Gale some rain squalls Lat 37.17 N Long 64.44 W

8 Tuesday 12th Come with fresh Gale from the N. steering E. S. E. and fine weather Middle part moderate some rain and the wind hauled to the N. N. E. the ship under all sail Latter part light wind from the N. and N. N. E. steering E. by S. and S. E. by E. saw 2 sails Lat 36.54

9 Wednesday 13th Come with wind from the N. N. steering E. by S. and a heavy swell broke out from the N. N. saw more sail the watch for water employed in breaking out for water Middle part calm and heavy swell Latter part fresh Gale from S. steering E. by S. and fine weather Pleasant weather

On Her Outward Bound Passage 1866

Nov 24
10 Thursday 13th Come with fresh Gale from the S. steering E. by S. and unpleasant weather Middle part at 10 P. M. took in sail and hove the ship too on the Starboard tack at 4 A. M. the weather growing more more ship on the Starboard tack to save the boats it. Blowing fresh from the S. with lightning Latter part the same until half past Eleven and the wind shifted to the North in the heaviest squall I ever saw taking the water up as it went and catching the ship aback and it became impossible for any thing to stand before it so ended the weather looking bad

11 Friday 16th Come with fresh Gale from the N. N. at 8 P. M. made some sail and cup the ship off steering E. by S. but found the skylight so leaky and so much water on deck luffed it again Middle part fresh Gale Latter part corked the skylight and at 8 A. M. made some sail steering E. by S. with heavy squalls Lat 37.128 N

12 Saturday 17th Come with fresh Gale from N. N. steering E. by S. with fresh squalls Middle part Latter part the same Lat 37.33 N Long 42.02 W

13 Sunday 18th Come with fresh Gale from the N. N. steering E. S. E. some rain squalls and unpleasant Middle part Latter part the same at 4 A. M. some of the seamen had a fit at the wheel and lasted some 10 minutes Lat 37.12 N
