Monday 11. Came with a light wind from the S. W. and increasing to fresh breeze steering along the Land to the Northward Eastward at 4 P. M. luffed to off shore and took in sail to wait for daylight to go in. Coasted the coast baring by compass N. E. distant 10 Miles saw a plenty of Humpbacks. Midday part light-wind and calmed the ship Laying off St. Carlos Heath Land. Latter part slight wind from the E. the ship trying to round in Port with a fair current.

Thursday ^(a) 12. Came with light air and calms
the ship heading in shore with the current
at 1 P.M. got the Anchor off the Bow at
2 P.M. the ship took Eddy current and came
very near going on to Corona Head the
Anchor brought her up in about noon her
Length at 3 P.M. took a light air from West
North took the Anchor and went in and
came to Anchor in 6 fathoms of water about
Mid way between the 2 Ports on San Carlos
side Manila
