

Remarks Log On Board Ship Cornithian

April

160 Monday 15th Bore with light wind from the E steering N N W at 5 P M the Boat came all hands off and made all sail Miala part light on Board trail from the E Latter part fine breeze at 8 P M from the E N E at 8 A M raise the Delance made all of Atori boring N by N

161 Tuesday 16th Bore with fine trail from came to the N E at 2 P M the Pilot came of anchor Brought the Ship to Anchor in 12 fathoms of water about noon greater of a Miala Island from the shore for recruits Miala and 14 P M Latter part light wind from the S and 4 water N W all hands employed in taking off 45 of Chum recruits and storing them below

162 Wednesday 17th Bore with light wind from at Anchor all points of the compass and fine weather at Atori Miala and Latter part the same all Island recruits on Board

163 Thursday 18th Bore with light wind from 5 Bullock the N and N W at 5 P M took the Anchor 6 3 1/2 P M and stood out to S E with all hands and of Potatoes Board at 7 P M the wind shifted to the E 50 Bunches during S M Miala and Latter part light of Bananas and other from all points of the compass 35 checking the Ship working to the North and west 18th ward for the Passage because the Islands of Oueheon and Tahoon at 8 A M there was a Stranger Reported on Board that arrived on Board at Atori Island

164 Friday 19th Bore with light wind from the Sounding the Ship on the North and Easton tack stranger on the Island of Oueheon North end boring N E by Boag and E distant 7 Leagues Middle part fresh wind killed from N N W and Thunder storm Latter noon part fresh trails from N E at 9 A M raise Bullock Birds Island boring N by N distant 10 Leagues killed a Bullock Lat 23:18 N Long 162:10 W

165 Saturday 20th Bore with fresh trail from the N E at 1 P M pass the Island of Kitting to the North of it distant 11 Miles at 3 cutting P M made all sail steering N N W by Great Compass Miala part fresh wind from N E but some rain squalls steering N N W Long 164:30 W

166 Sunday 21st Bore with light wind from E to employed N E steering N N W the watch employed in various jobs Miala and Latter Jobs part fresh wind from the N and N W the ship on opposite tack some rain squalls Lat 26:59 N

167 Monday 22nd Bore with fresh wind from Miala part N N W the ship on the North and Easton tack a few passing rain squalls Miala raining and Latter part the same the watch employed in Evening Ship

168 Tuesday 23rd Bore with light wind from N N W the ship on the North and Easton tack the watch employed in Evening Ship Miala part calm Latter part light Bullock wind from N the ship on the North tack Lat 28:38 N Long 163:36 W
