202 Monday 27th Cove with fine rain from NW and some fog at 3 P.M. back ship of from the Ice on the western back the Eagle in sight. Midair and latter part light Gale from the NW the ship off and on the Ice of Capt. Chadeau see a few ships and plenty of Ice Lat 63:00 Long 179:05

203 Tuesday 28th Cove with fine clear weather G. Wind and light Gale from the N the ship on Eagle and off the Ice Midair part fresh breeze Dec 3rd from the N latter part light rain cutting ships from the N N W the ship on the North B. Bear and Eastern back saw a number of ships and a goodly Breeze a Boiling pot of West plenty of Ice Lat 63:24 Long 178:05

204 Wednesday 29th Cove with fine breeze from NW at 1 P.M. saw a Boarhead whale and four but no luck came on Board. 4 ships cutting Midair and latter part light air and calm saw a few ships a Whaling but see no whales plenty of Ice Lat 63:23 Long 178:29

205 Thursday 30th Cove with light air and calm 4 ships a Boiling and saw a Whaling at 4 P.M. wind Boiling and East and some snow the ship in the Ice Midair part light air from all points of the compass some rain and fine snow latter part light air and calm thick fog and thick fog the ship in the Ice

206 Friday 31st Cove with light air and calm and thick fog thick fog at 3 P.M. the fog light saw 11 sails at spoke the 6 P.M. the fog came in again the ship in the Ice Rainier Midair and latter part light rain from SE and thick fog the ship of and on the Ice

209 Monday 3rd Cove with light wind from the E foggy spoke the ship on the Southern back some fog at 6 P.M. the ship spoke the ship Muringo Midair and latter part Muringo light rain from the E and E S E and a thick fog the most of the time at 9 P.M. back of from the Ice to the North and Eastward Lat 62:42 N

210 Tuesday 4th Cove with light wind from the Hokelua E ship beating along to the Eastward with 4 ships at 4 P.M. saw 6 number of ships at 4 P.M. Eagle & luffice to and head again with John P. West Hauling and Aeline & Eagle all of New Bedford Midair part steering to the North West broke out along the Ice latter part at 6 P.M. came for water up to the Ice and entered it steering N W and N N W the wind light from E the Eagle & Aeline in sight Lat 64:15 N Long 177:38 W
