

Remarks made on Board Ship Cometham

211 ^{June 6th} Wednesday^a Come with light wind from the E the ship steering to the North through the Ice the Bk Eagle & Adeline in sight at 4 P.M. eight or 2 more ships North of us. Made the port at 9 P.M. came into clear water. Latter part at 6 A.M. came into the Ice gaining slowly. At 10 A.M. raised Cape Atkin having by compass 17 ships in sight and more a Boiling the wind for E to SE some snow squalls

212 ^{Thursday} 6th Come with fine breeze from the E to SE at 1 P.M. luffed to the wind in Bering Count side the Ice at 3 P.M. the natives came on board the ship working to the Eastward on Board along the land a plenty of ships in sight but no whales. In the evening a snow squall and fog the ship under all sail working to the E and saw a number of ships between E and the land in sight at different times

213 ^{Friday} 7th Come with light wind from the Ship of Emma and hauling to the Westward at 2 P.M. saw Cape Chokolski bearing N by E distant 5 leagues spoke Bk and 11 ships 2 a boiling at 5 P.M. spoke the Bk R. Toward of Larny at Anchor a Boiling 3 ships. Males reports plenty of Whales for the East. At 10 A.M. at 7 P.M. bore the ship G. Dickson 3 or 4 miles of N.W. 6 Whales reports shot having from 11 ships 3 to 11. Whales came on board with the blood in a thick fog at 9 P.M. heaved to and took in sail it a thick fog. Mice & Latter part light wind from the land thick fog and cold the ship under short sail saw 2 ships Lat 64:04 N
