226 Thursday 2^o Come with light wind from the Southward at 1 P.M. four boats for whales
 at 4 P.M. came on board no luck the whaling
 of whales but the Miado part light air and calmed at 9 P.M.
 spoke the Bk. Massachusetts 14 Whales saw
 a few whales and a number of ships and whaling
 and a cutting. Latter part light wind from
 West came fog at 7 A.M. four boats for a
 whale at 9 A.M. spoke the Bk. Nantuxet 9 Whales
 at 11 A.M. the boat came on board with long
 faces and no whales in a number but shy

 from SE at 3 A.M. four boats for whales but

 Bk. (Mass) E by compass
 Lat 67° 57' N
 Long 168° 28' W

229 Sunday 2^o Come with fine wind from SE at 8 A.M.
 four boats for a whale the boat struck and at
 8 P.M. took him along side the same in sight to
 the South of Point Hope Miado part at 1 A.M. the
 fine sh cutting Latter part fine weather at 11 A.M.
 started the works the ship on different
 tack saw a few ships
 Lat 68° 10' N

 wind SE the ship steering N N W along the
 Canadian Dec Miado and Latter part light and
 and calm saw a few whales and ships a
 whaling at 10 A.M. four boats for whales but no luck
 came on board and got dinner light wind
 from the SE plenty of ships and few whales

231 Tuesday 2^o Come with fine wind from the
 NE at 2 P.M. four boats for whales the Larbood
 Boat struck at 4 P.M. took him along side a
 fine whale Capt. Wiley came on board of the
 Bk. President 17 whales the season for letters
 at 5 P.M. commenced to cut Miado part
 at 10 P.M. finish cutting and set the watch
 Latter part light wind from SE and pleasant
 weather see no whales at 9 A.M. started the
 Cog works see 30 ships 2 Boiling Lat 68° 16' N
 Long 170° 28' W

232 Wednesday 2^o Come with light wind from
 the NE and pleasant see no whales but a
 plenty of ships Miado and Latter part light
 wind from the NE and fine weather
 Lat 68° 39' N

233 Thursday 2^o Come with light wind from N
 the ship working in the Dec to the Eastward
 none Bk. is sight a cutting but none see no
 spoke the whales Miado part fine weather and
 Bk. Deke part fresh wind from the N and some fog
 Carver steering N S W saw 2 ships Lat 68° 12' N
 Long 170° 28' W

234 Friday 2^o Come with fresh wind from N and
 some fog steering N S W under easy sail
 Miado and Latter part fresh wind from N
 and thick fog the most of the time at 10 A.M. spoke
 George Howland 4 whales
