July 1867

235 Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> Come with light winds from the N and some fog at 4 P.M. finish Boiling at 8 P.M. but 3 seals for roasting but no luck. Mianan part at 11 P.M. came on Board. Latter part fine pleasant weather wind from the S. The ship on the N tack all hands employed in storing away. Lat 68° 12' N Long 168° 33' W

336 Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> Come with light winds from the S. E. and S. at 4 P.M. could with the following ships Th. Dickenson 8 whales. Active 3. P. Marshall 3 whales John Corver 2 whales. at 5 P.M. finish storing away. Mianan part roasts the same ship on the Easton tack. Latter part the same plenty of ships going in all directions but no whales. 1 ship a Boiling. Lat 68° 20' N Long 168° 26' W

237 Monday 1<sup>st</sup> Come with fine winds from S. E. and pleasant weather see plenty of ship but no whales the ship on the Easton tack. Mianan part thick fog at 11 P.M. saw a whale but it being a thick fog lost him of him and not lost. Latter part thick fog the most of the time at 8 A.M. saw the B.B. Active went of no Bear of him and head a gain of 11 A.M. the fog light saw a number of ships - Calves. Lat 68° 18' N

238 Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> Come with calms and light East-ly E. Mrs employed in gunning at 9 P.M. took up the gun Mianan part the ship running along the Ocean and to the Eastward pleasant weather. Latter part light winds from N to N.E. steering S and S. S. W. Lat 67° 40' N Long 168° 05' W

239 Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> Come with light winds from E. and S. E. at 4 P.M. steering S. and S. W. by W. sick of saw a few ship but no fine pleasant weather. Auty 3 Mianan part fine winds from the N. E. Cape steering N. S. W. Latter part the same the same George and Oceana 4 ships in sight. Lat 67° 40' N Long 172° 43' W

240 Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> Come with fresh winds from N. E. the ship on the same. Mianan part 8 ships in sight and 1 a Whaling or Boiling. Mianan and Latter part fresh winds from the N. E. the ship on different tacks saw 2 ships a cutting but see no whales. Lat 69° 00' N Long 174° 10' W

241 Friday 5<sup>th</sup> Come with light gales from the N. E. the ship on different tacks saw the Ice and some ships a Boiling. Mianan and Latter part fresh winds from the E. N. E. the ship of Berg & working to the north along the Ice thick heavy weather and some foggy. Lat 69° 35' N Long 172° 54' W

242 Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> Come with light rains from E. saw 30 ships thick fog the most of the time saw 2 ships and 1 a whaling and 2 a Boiling. Mianan part saw a whale and foggy saw the B.B. (Harrison) take a whale 4 a Boiling. Latter part light winds from the S. and but see no smoke weather saw 4 ships a Boiling the whaled ship off and on the Ice. Lat 69° 56' N Long 174° 24' W

243 Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> Come with light winds from the S. E. the ship of and on the Ice at 4 P.M. spoke 1 ship the B.B. Lyain of N. B. 1 whale Mianan part plenty of and Latter part the same saw the ship Th. Corver take a small whale the ship of and whaled in the Ice working to the Southward. Lat 69° 35' N Long 172° 54' W
