

Remarks Log On Board Ship Cornithian

July 1867

244 Monday⁸ Came with fine wind from the north-east & the ship on the Easton tack under all 8 no ship sail. Mianaw part light wind from S & E the ship on the Easton tack at 3 A M came up to scattering. See saw 5 ships. Latter part came fog. The ship in the ice at 9 A M the fog light the ship came out of the ice right round from E & ship in sight Lat 69:29

246 Tuesday⁹ Came with light air from the foggy no wind. It cleared for a few miles at 2 P M the wind met and a thick fog. The ship taking a back Mianaw part light wind from the W at 10 P M the fog light the ship off and on the ice thick fog weather. Latter part the fog Bk Chigard at same wind S W at 8 A M spoke the Bk Chigard no whale and 3 ship sacks the capt came on board and heard a gun Lat 68:59 N

247 Wednesday¹⁰ Came with light wind from the S W the ship on the N W tack in company with the Chigard at 8 P M parted company at 9 P M took ship to the S W the wind N W by W and fog. Mianaw and latter part light wind from the S W and calmed thick fog the most of the time no sun

248 Thursday¹¹ Came with light air and calm a strong current setting to the S W and thick cloudy weather the ship on the N and Weston tack Mianaw and latter part light wind from the N and some fog the ship standing to the N and West along the ice no sun

249 Friday¹² Came with light wind from the north-east the ship on the North & Weston tack but some running along the ice some fog thick cloudy weather Mianaw and latter part fog the most of the time the ship running along the ice to the north and west round the Bk Chigard in sight no whales Lat 70:27 N Long 175:05 W

250 Saturday¹³ Came with fresh wind from N N 30 miles E & foggy ice squealed running along the ice to the S W spoke 3 ships at 4 P M spoke the Bk Chigard at 5 P M lower 3 boats for whales Mianaw part fresh wind from N at 9 P M the doctor boat struck at 10 P M took him along side at 3 A M finished cutting 17 ships in sight at 4 A M lower 2 boats for whales the Bk Chigard Boro Boat frozen round round latter part the wind and weather the same saw 2 whales taken the Bk Melin & Chigard Lat 70:33 N

251 Sunday¹⁴ Came with fine wind and weather from N E at 2 P M raised Herald Chigard - Chigard baring by compass N W distant 50 miles saw a number of ships a whaling 24 ships plenty of ships in sight at 6 P M started 1 whale taken the Bk Chigard Mianaw and latter part fine weather the ship in and around the ice in a plenty of whales but a few whales Lat 70:50 N

252 Monday¹⁵ Came with light N E wind and fine weather plenty of ice & ships and few whales at 4 P M spoke the Bk Chigard and heard a shot gun at 7 P M lower 3 boats for whales but no chance Mianaw part the same latter part fog Lat 71:03 N Long 175:09 W
