

Remarks Made On Board Ship Cornithian

Sept 1864

324 Saturday 21st Come with light wind from the N and fine weather saw a number of whales and a number of ships a whaling and some a cutting but see no chance to take a ship in sight. Mice part fresh wind from the N. Latter part light Gale from the N. N. W. saw in the morning a number of whales going to the N. N. W. quick no chance to take for them some snow squalls. Lat 40° 28' N Long 173° 49' W

325 Sunday 22nd Come with light gales plenty of ships but no whales. Saw the ship *Grey Heron* Boiling her 6 whales at 5 P.M. mona wind Mice part light wind. Latter part light wind from the N. and some snow squalls saw a number of whales but going quick no chance to take a ship. Boiling. Lat 40° 27' N Long 174° 40' W

326 Monday 23rd Come with light wind from the N at 2 P.M. four 3 Boats for whales but not see him again. The Boats came on Board at 10 o'clock. saw a number of whales in the light sails. Mice part water & calms. Latter part light wind from the S. and fine weather saw 1 whale but no chance. Molasses to four saw 3 ships a Boiling and a whaling & chase the ship on opposite tack. Lat 40° 37' N

327 Tuesday 24th Come with fresh wind from the S at 2 P.M. four 3 Boats for a whale but never did not see him again. Saw a number of ships. Island a whaling at sun down took in sail. Herold Island bearing N. N. W. distant 10 Leagues. Mice and Latter part wind the same. The Island bearing N. N. W. saw some ships a whaling but see no whales steering different courses.

While Cruising On The Arctic Cruise

Wednesday 25th Come with light gales from the S. I saw a number of whales at 4 P.M. four 3 boats for a whale at 6 P.M. took him along side at 8 P.M. commenced to cut Mice part rain. E. & E. at 3 A.M. finish cutting. Latter part wind the same saw a few whales and look for them but no luck. The Island bearing S. N. distant 8 Leagues.

Thursday 26th Come with light gales from S. saw a plenty of whales and 6 ships at 3 P.M. four 3 boats at 5 P.M. took a whale along side at 6 P.M. commenced to cut Mice part at 11 P.M. finish cutting. Latter part light wind from the S. and plenty of whales at 8 A.M. four 4 boats at 11 A.M. the 3rd Boat struck the Island bearing S. by E. distant 12 Leagues. 6 ships in sight a whaling and the Ice a strong current setting to the North.

Friday 27th Come with light wind from the S. N. the Ice bearing from N. W. to N. at 1 P.M. took a whale along side and plenty of whales in sight at 3 P.M. commenced to cut more boat a whaling at 4 P.M. finish cutting at 8 o'clock the watch some snow Mice part wind S. N. the ship on the East long tack with all sail out. Latter part at 6 A.M. started the tryworks. Lat 41° 37' N Long 176° 26' W

Saturday 28th Come with fine wind from the S. the ship on the West long tack at 2 P.M. four 3 boats for whales at 5 P.M. took more along side at 7 finish cutting at sun down the Island bearing S. by N. distant 30 miles. Mice part fresh wind from S. N. Latter part light gales from S. N. saw a number of ships a Boiling. Lat 41° 47' N
