

Remarks Pass On Board Ship Cornuthian

Oct 1867

348 Tuesday 13th Come with fresh Gale from N steering S S W by compass at 4 P M
 Light Island bearing E by N distant 25 Miles
 Micae part fresh Gale from the N W at 11 P M luffed to on the Easton tack under short sail to water for daylight Latter part the wind St. Lawrence Island bearing E by N distant 20 Miles
 S. S. W some Gale squalls at 9 A M when S. Lawrence Island the West End bearing S W distant 20 Miles Lat 63° 44' N Long 171° 55' W

349 Wednesday 14th Come with fine wind from the N the ship under all sail steering E by S or E by E at 4 P M the South End of St. Lawrence Island bearing E N E by compass more Bk. in sight Micae part fresh wind from the West and S W some rain Latter part wind from S W and S S W and thick rainy weather no seen the watch employed in skimming ship no seen

350 Thursday 15th Come with fresh wind from the S and thick weather the ship on the Easton tack under easy sail in 40 fathoms of water at 6 P M light breeze ship Micae part at 10 P M more ship to the S W light gale from the S and some rain Latter part fresh Gale from the S S W more ship in sight on the S and Easton tack under Main Spencer and Fore top mast stay sail Lat 60° 30' N Long 170° 21' W

On Hear Friday from the North to S. Island

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351 Friday 18th Come with fresh Gale from the S S W at 4 P M the ship under close reef Main top sail on the Weston tack Micae part light the Gale moderates made some sail Latter part fresh wind from the S and S S W and S E the ship on the Weston tack Lat 60° 35' N Long 171° 46' W

352 Saturday 19th Come with fresh wind on light Gale from the ship on the Weston tack at 3 P M raised the Island of St. Matthew bearing S S W distant 20 Miles Micae part calms and light wind from the N steering S S E Latter part light Gale from the N and thick snow storm at 8 A M pass Cape Unupright distant 4 Miles the ship under all sail steering S E by S no seen

353 Sunday 20th Come with fresh Gale from the N at 4 P M it cleared up some and the wind hauled to the N W steering S S E and a bad swell from the West Micae part the same at 10 A M sight of Pauls Island bearing S S E distant 30 Miles light rain and heavy swell from the West and Lat 56° 35' N Long 171° 00' W

354 Monday 21st Come with light wind from the N W and a heavy swell from the N and took in a few snow squalls at 4 P M steering S by E by compass Micae part light wind West Boat hauled the N W to N and snow squalls steering S by E Latter part light wind from the N cutting stays to N N W steering S by E saw 2 ships steering the same took in the Fore & Mast Boat and took in the Big cutting stay Lat 54° 47' N Long 171° 42' W
