 364 Monday 4th Bore with light air and calms
 caught from all points of the compass at 3 P.M.
 3 dolphins came up a rain squall with light air
 from all points of the compass Midair and
 Put out Latter part light winds from the N steering
 the Bore S by E at 7 A.M. put out the Bore
 already ready to wash Bore some rain squalls
 Lat 25:34 N
 Long 156:16 W
 364 Tuesday 5th Bore with light winds from N
 washing steering SE by E the watch employed in washing
 Bore Bore fine pleasant weather Midair & Latter
 part fine winds from N steering SE a few
 passing rain squalls all hands employed in
