414 Thursday 26 Come with light wind from the E and fine weather at 1 P.M. the Anchor. Left Hope Island steering W by S at 8 A.M. spoke the Bk. John Carver and head a cane
 Lat 21° 54' S
 Long 176° 02' E

415 Friday 27 Come with light wind from the E steering N by compass in company Chase with the John Carver at 3 P.M. said Island chased Island at 4 P.M. luffed to and the Native came off with chickens to the lower tract took 200 on board at unknown took in sail standing off and on the Island Miaata and latter part the wind and weather the same at daylight made all sail steering N.W. at 11 A.M. said Drummond Island the John C in company
 Lat 20° 3' S

416 Saturday 28 Come with light wind from Drummond the E at 4 P.M. the Native came on board with a few shells to trade Miaata and latter part light wind and calm the Island in sight but no notes
 Lat 11° 43' S
 Long 175° 35' E

417 Sunday 29 Come with light wind from Drummond the E at 1 P.M. the Native came on board Island the John Carver in sight the ship under all sail Miaata and latter part light wind and fine weather the ship off and on Drummond Island see nothing but Native and John Carver
 Lat 11° 20' S

418 Monday 30 Come with light wind from the E Drummond and E the ship of and Drummond Island at 4 P.M. spoke the Bk. John Carver and head a cane Miaata and latter part light wind from E and N.E. steering cover along the Island to the Westward at 11 A.M. said again Island at 11 A.M. run into shore water Lat 11° 02'

419 Tuesday 31 Come with light wind from N.E. Drummond at 3 P.M. the Native came on board and alone some trading for Cocoanuts and shell the John Carver still in sight Miaata and latter part fine weather light wind from the E to N.E. see a plenty of Black Fish but know what the Native on board with little of nothing
 Lat 11° 04' S

Wednesday 31 this is the last day of the month and year and a day to make in the date and day so ends the Year of 1867 and 900 Bbs of Oil all told off and our Drummond Island all well clear from Honolulu and almost 14 days or months out and have not seen a sign of a Spirit Nalo cruise having ten Beagles but still live in hopes of seeing them this year North Lewis had a crow call to day and hunt her head
