430 Saturday 11th Come with fine winds from
John. C. the N and N E some rain in squalls the
Bk being ship on short tack beating to the windward but
Ocean 2 in nothing at 3 P.M. the Bk took up her
boats Miaad and Latter part light rain
from all points of the compass and fresh
squalls of rain and wind from S and
S N the Island bearing N

431 Sunday 12th Come with fresh squalls of
rain rain did wind the ship under short
put out sail Miaad and Latter part fine
the latter part fine from the N at daylight made
Boat all sail steering N N W for Ocean Island
in company with the John barrow the Bk.
J. barrow Bk in sight at 11 A.M. Hauled the Main
Ocean Tard added for the natives to come on board
Ocean the Island distant 1 League sent 3 Boats
Mut. Bk on shore to trade

432 Monday 13th Come with fresh winds and
Ocean squally in the distance at 3 P.M. the Boats
Ocean came on Board with 200 chickens and a
few coconuts and a plenty of Brown stuff
at 4 P.M. steering N Miaad and Latter
part squally, wind from all points of the
compass the ship under easy sail the Island
in sight and 2 ships

433 Tuesday 14th Come with light winds from N N
J. barrow the ship on the North and West tack
saw a fair back Miaad and Latter wind
Ocean from the N and N. S. N some rain
Island squalls and unpleasant weather the
ship on opposite tack under easy sail
and time of Bk Lat 00.33 S

434 Wednesday 15th Come with fresh winds from
Ocean the Main N. S. N the ship on opposite tack
Ocean at sunrise about 10 the Bk sailed some
fresh squalls Miaad and Latter part the
J. barrow some plenty of rain no sun

435 Thursday 16th Come with light wind from N
J. barrow the ship on the North tack under all sail
Ocean Island in sight bearing by compass
E. S. E Miaad and Latter part light air and
Ocean calm from all points of the compass some
Island squalls of rain Lat 00.27 S

436 Friday 17th Come with light air from the
look in N E steering N by S under all sail Miaad
the latter part light wind from all points of the
B Boat compass and calm and torments of rain
rain Latter part light wind from the E and fine
weather steering N by S Lat 00.23 S
Long 169.16 E

437 Saturday 18th Come with light wind from the
E steering N by S fine pleasant weather
but and Miaad and Latter part light wind from
old Main the E and S E steering N by S fine pleasant
weather the ship under all sail Lat 00.30 S
Long 168.00 E

438 Sunday 19th Come with light wind from S E
put out the steering N by S some rain squalls in the distance
J. barrow Miaad part light wind from the E at 1 A.M.
Boat took in sail and heaved to a back for
Pasant Island Latter part wind and
weather the same at daylight rain Pleasant
Island distant 3 Leagues at 10 A.M. the
Native came on Board at 11 A.M. sent
in 2 boats to trade the John barrow and
Cicco at the Island
