- 467 Tuesday 18th Come with strong trades from the N. N. E. the ship on the Northern tack. Micaud part fresh trades from the N. N. E. the ship on opposite tack. Latter part light wind from the N. the ship on the Western tack the watch employed in Repairing the top sail Lat 20:153 N Long 143 00 E
