508 Tuesday 24th Come with light gales from
the N the ship on the Easton tack Middle and
after part light gales from N the ship on
opposite tack from 11 P.M. to 3 A.M. at 4 A.M.
Repaired sent down the main spinnaker to Repair
Main Spinnaker pleasant the ship on the Easton tack Lat 40.40
East Long 138.30

509 Wednesday 25th Come with fine wind from
covered the N N steering N E by E pleasant weather
the boiler Middle part fine wind from N N
cover steering N E by E at midnight took in
some sail and stood off to the West
ward at 3 A.M. wore ship to the N E
at 4 A.M. made all sail steering N E by E
for Sugar Straits Latter part wind and
weather the same at 9 A.M. entered the
mouth of the Straits

510 Thursday 26th Come with fresh gales from
the N N steering along the land to the N
and Eastward at 3 P.M. got the Anchor
off the Bar thick snow storm at 5 P.M.
came to Anchor off the Fort of Hakadadi
in 4 fathoms of water the Fort bearing N by Com
65 fathoms

511 Thursday 27th Come with fresh wind from
the N N at 6 A.M. heaved the anchor
and took the Anchor and our keel out
Hakadadi of the Bay of Hakadadi at 10 A.M. made
all sail steering by compass E by S at 11 A.M.
passed a small Steamer bound to
Hakadadi at 11 A.M. took the Anchor on the
Bar

put out N E the ship on the South and Easton tack
a New L.B. at 1 P.M. it lit up and stopped snowing saw
Boat the S E Head Land of Matsonia bearing N
broke out the ship under close reef top sails and storm
for Meet Stayed Midway and Latter part light air
and calm and pleasant the S E Head of Matsonia
Island bearing N 30 Miles

steering E by S a heavy swell from the S pleasant
weather the S E Head Land of Matsonia bearing
N distant 10 Leagues Middle part light wind
from the S steering E by compass Latter part
fresh wind from S E steering E N E see a
plenty of Rite Whales Lat 42.00 N
Long 146.00 E
