

Remarks Last Cow Board Ship Contin

April 1868

Sunday 26 Come with fresh Gale from the E the ship on the South & Eastern tack under 3 close reefed topsails and storm top sails some snow ahead and latter part fresh Gale from the E and plenty of snow the ship on the Southern tack

Monday 27 Come with light gales the E at 1 spoke the P.M. made some sail at 3 P.M. wore ship to the N ship ran in and at 5 P.M. spoke the ship Ranier Miaow and latter part light Gale from the E and a heavy swell from the S E and thick cloudy weather some rain and snow Lat 60° 15' N

Tuesday 28 Come with light gales from the E S E the ship on the North and Eastern tack some snow and thick weather a heavy swell from the S E Miaow latter part light gales and a heavy swell from the S E some rain and snow and foggy sail saw ship steering N E by compass and some snow and rain Lat 60° 30' N Long 176° 20' E

Wednesday 29 Come with light wind from the N steering N by compass a heavy swell from the S E see nothing Miaow and latter part fresh wind from N and south steering N some rain and a plenty of snow

Thursday 30 Come with light wind from N and at 3 P.M. came up to the ice and spoke the ship Lydia and heard a gun saw a number of ships Miaow part at 10 P.M. spoke the E. Now came latter part fresh wind from N the ship off area on the Dec 31 ship in sight ship a boiling cap Navarin bearing 30 Miles distant N by N

Friday 1 Come with fresh wind from N the ship off area on the Dec cap Navarin bearing N N distance 30 Miles Miaow part fresh wind from the N and N. N. W latter part wind the same at 6 A.M. came up to the ice and steering N into the ice in the company of 15 ships cap Navarin bearing N. N. W 30 Miles of Lat 61° 51' N

Saturday 2 Come with light wind from S W steering N in the Dec 31 ship in sight steering N at 6 P.M. raised ahead and at 7 struck him and lost the line and came on board struck with sails hoisted Miaow some East and a heavy swell from S the ship under easy sail the line latter part fresh wind from the S E and a snow storm at 10 A.M. wore ship to the East cap Navarin made cap Navarin bearing S by N saw 16 ships in the ice Lat 62° 19' N

Sunday 3 Come with fresh wind from N and clear the ship laying in the ice under main top cap Navarin and top mast staysail cap Navarin bearing S by N distant 20 Miles Miaow part fresh wind from the N at 11 P.M. the ship became stuck in the ice immovable latter part wind the same and very cold but the ship under some headway cap Navarin bearing N by N the ship making a S E drift

Monday 4 Come with light wind and some snow the ship on the Eastern tack in the Dec 30 ship in sight the wind from S E and a swell from S Miaow part calms latter part light wind from S. S. E and S N the ship working to the North under all sail 29 ships in sight and a boiling the cap N N distant 20 Miles
