

Remarks Pass On Board Ship Corinthian

May 1868

565 Tuesday 19th Com with light wind from the
Dec Lat 3 P M tack ship to the S W in the Dec room
Brigg in sight in the Dec. Miaad part fine wind
from the E N E at 2 A M came out of the
Dec at 4 A M made all sail steering to the
South and Westward along the Dec
Latter part fresh wind from the E N E
and a thick snow storm the ship running
along the Dec to the South and West wind
see no ships Lat 61.00 N

566 Wednesday 20th Com with light wind from
the E N E the ship running along the Dec
to the South and Westward some snow the
weather quite warm. Miaad part fresh wind
from the N E and S. S. E. the ship running along
the Southern edge of the Dec under easy sail
Latter part fine wind from the S and S W
and pleasant moon Bk. in sight at 9 A M pass
the Last Dec Cape Navarin bearing N E by compass
plenty of Sulphur bottoms in sight Lat 61.51 N
Long 178.15 E

567 Thursday 21st Com with light wind from
Cape Navarin the S W and N. S. W the ship steering N E one
bearing N E Bk. in sight Miaad and Latter part light
wind from the S W at 10 A M spoke a
German Bk. Count Beismark and heard a
Cape Navarin at 11 A M bearing N W
distant 8 Miles found the Dec quite open
Lat 62.04 N

While On Her Northern Cruise

May 1868

568 Friday 22nd Com with light wind from the
S W at 1 P M entered the Dec steering N E
the Bk. in company at 4 P M broke up the
Cape Navarin bearing N W distant
15 Miles Miaad and Latter part fine wind
from the S at 3 A M luffed to in the Dec at 7 A M
made some sail steering to the S and Eastward
saw a number of ships in the Dec Lat 62.11 N

569 Saturday 23rd Com with fresh wind from the
S at 3 P M raised about all of the fleet in the Dec
the ship bearing from N E to S Dec bound at 4 P M luffed
to in a clear spot of water at 4 P M the captain
of the Bk. Miller Snow came on board and heard
a short Cape Navarin and Latter part light
wind from the S. S. W. the ship in a small place
38 ships of clear water with 3 other Bks at 8 A M the
Bk. capt. of the Bk. Niagara came on board
at head a game Lat 63.30 N
Long 178.39 W

570 Sunday 24th Com with fresh wind from
the S the ship in a clear spot of water at 1 P M
capt. Berd came on board and heard a
38 ships came Miaad part some fog and light air
Latter part wind light from the S and snow
the ship under sail steering N E and S Lat 63.40 N

571 Monday 25th Com with light wind from the
S. S. W and increasing some snow at 1 P M
came up to the solid Dec took in sail in
the ship clear water the ship laying a back Miaad
and Latter part light wind from the S W some
1 Bk. a Whaling in the Dec Lat 63.40 N
