

Remarks Log On Board Ship Corinthian

June 1868

604 Saturday 27th Come with light wind from the E and rain at 1 P.M. four 5 Boats for Rip sacks at 4 P.M. came on Board no light 3 ships in sight. Midair part fresh wind from the E & N E steering N by compass at 3 A.M. saw the South Head Head of St. Lawrence Bay from N E latter part wind E the ship on opposite tack of and on the land and sea under double reef top sails with fog and rain

605 Sunday 28th Come with light wind from the E & E and a thick rainy weather the ship on short tacks of and on the land Midair some back part light wind from E thick fog and of Board rain latter part light air from the S. E and thick fog

606 Monday 29th Come with light air from land fog at 2 P.M. the fog light up for a few minutes made all sail steering N by compass the S Head of St. Lawrence Bay bearing N N distant 7 leagues saw 3 ships at anchor under the North head of the Bay Midair part light wind from S N steering E & E thick fog the most of the time latter part light air and calm thick fog all of the time

607 Tuesday 30th Come with light air and calm and a thick fog Midair part the same latter part light wind from N E and clear weather Kings Island bearing E distant 5 leagues at 5 P.M. four 2 Boats for Rip sacks but found them very shy at 7 A.M. came on Board

While On Her Northern Cruise

July 1868

608 Wednesday 1st Come with light wind from E at 1 P.M. four 4 Boats for Rip sacks the Carboara Boat struck and Drow Broke lost the whale wind E and rain and fog the Nation on Board from Kings Island Midair and latter part light wind from the E & E to I thick fog the most of the time the ship on opposite tacks at 11 A.M. and the fog lifted saw Cape Prince of Wales

609 Thursday 2nd Come with light wind from the Cape Prince some fog at 2 P.M. the Nation came on Board of Water to trade steering N N by compass Midair and latter part light wind from the land some fog Boiling steering N. N. N. and N. N. N. saw 8 ships and much boiling at 8 A.M. started the Lat 66° 41' N

610 Friday 3rd Come with light wind from the E Broke steering along the land near Cape Surge & Ship out but no sight and a fog Bank off shore and to the South of us the watch employed in Boiling Boiling Midair part light wind from the S and calm at 11 P.M. 2 Nations came off from Cape Surge latter part light wind from the Boiling It saw a few ships Lat 67° 02'

611 Saturday 4th Come with fresh wind from S Lockett at 3 P.M. spoke the ship Cor. Kowiana and C. Kowiana California & Concordia and heard a cannon at California Midair part at 11 P.M. finish running the ship Concordia on the Easton tack at 1 A.M. came in thick fog took in sail and hauled back latter part thick fog the ship on the Easton tack aback strong wind from N N
