

Peru's Date On Board Ship Cornithian

July 1868

629 *Wednesday 22* Come with light winds from N & S the ship off and on the ice saw 3 ships a Malrusing and some a Boiling some fog. Micaco and latter part light winds from the N and thick fog at 8 A.M. sent in the ice 4 Boats after Malrus at noon 2 boats came back with 1 Malrus

630 *Thursday 23* Come with light winds from the N & S the Boats in the ice a Malrusing at 4 P.M. 3 boats came off with 6 and 4 Malrus and some Barc got supper and set the watch and sent the Eskimo in the ice after the missing Boat at 7 P.M. the fog light Micaco part fine wind and clear at 10 P.M. the last boats came off from the ice for the night latter part wind N at 6 A.M. sent 2 Boats in the ice after Malrus at 8 A.M. four 3 other Boats and sent them in after Malrus thick fog the most of the line at 11 A.M. the Harbora Boat came on Board

631 *Friday 24* Come with light winds from the N the ship off and on the ice all of the Boats in after Malrus at 7 P.M. all of the Boats came on Board for the night Micaco part wind from the N & S the ship off and on the ice some fog. latter part light winds from N & S at 4 A.M. sent in 3 Boats for Malrus at 9 A.M. sent in 2 more in a few Malrus and 3 ships some rain and cloudy weather

Whick On Her Northan Cruised 1868

July 1868

632 *Saturday 25* Come with fresh winds from the N & S the ship off and on the ice saw 16 Malrus and cloudy weather some rain at 4 P.M. the last Boat came on Board from Cerio Malrusing it a thick fog at 5 P.M. spoke the Barquet Cerio Micaco part wind from the N and thick fog some rain latter part wind N and S at 10 A.M. the fog light some at 10 A.M. four 2 Boats and sent them in the ice after Malrus 3 ships in sight Lat 68° 39' N Long 172° 31' W

633 *Sunday 26* Come with light winds from S & N some fog at 1 P.M. four 3 Boats and sent them in spoke the ice after Malrus 5 ships a Malrusing at 4 P.M. the Boats came on Board with 28 Malrus Micaco part wind S. S. W. and pleasant latter part at 7 A.M. four all 5 Boats and sent them in the ice after Malrus fresh wind from S and clear weather 5 ships in sight a Malrusing Lat 68° 37' N Long 168° 30' W

634 *Monday 27* Come with fresh winds from the N and clear at 5 P.M. all of the Boats came on Board with 34 Malrus double Ruff the top sailed the ship on the Easton tack Micaco part fresh winds from S & N and clear latter part light gales from N & W and rain

635 *Tuesday 28* Come with light winds from N & W and clear unpleasant at 4 P.M. it moderated at 7 P.M. came up to the ice four 2 Boats for Malrus Micaco part fine weather at 1 A.M. sent 2 more Boats after Malrus at 2 A.M. some boat returned on Board with 6 Malrus 30 Malrus at 3 A.M. the Harbora Boat came on Board with 10 Malrus latter part fine weather all 5 Boats in the ice after Malrus
