643 Monday 3rd Come with light winds from California. Wall hauls employed in stowing down Oil and Boiling the ship laying by the Dec. gunner easy sail at 3 P.M. went at Board ship California to get the muss. Miaad part

quick light sails from N.W. some snow squalls Boiling steering E by S and E a Boiling saw a number of ships latter part light gales from the N.W. with squalls of snow at 9 A.M. finish Boiling Cape Lisburne Baring

Cape Lisburne E by S steering N.E. at 10 A.M. luffed to the Northward by the snow ships in sight 2 a Boiling

644 Tuesday 4th Come with light winds from N.W. Breaking the ship on the Northward took plenty of snow out for meat. squalls in a few ships and 2 a Boiling Cape Lisburne Baring E by S by compass the Miaad and latter part light gales from the N.W. with fresh squalls of snow all hands employed in stowing down Oil Cape Lisburne in sight to the Eastward of us Lat 69° 40'

645 Friday 7th Come with light gales from N.W. with 189 Bbls fresh squalls of snow all hands employed in stowing down Oil at 7 P.M. finish stowing 189 Bbls in the after Hatch. Miaad and latter part light winds from the N.W. and calms the watch employed in setting up water pipes some snow squalls and a cold Cape Lisburne Baring N.E. by N distant 30 miles the ship under all sail steering N.E. bound in after water

While On Her Northward Cruise 1868

646 Saturday 8th Come with light winds from the N.W. steering N.E. for the Cape fine weather at 4 P.M. got the chain on deck all ready to anchor. Picka over 7 P.M. sent the Raft on shore with 3 Boats. Retained the ship off and on the station on Board

647 Monday 11th Part fine weather light winds from N.E. at midnight the Boats came on Board with the Raft latter part light winds from N.E. and N.W. the ship on the N.W. and Westward took the Cape Baring N.E. by E distant 10 leagues the cooper Repairing the Board Boat

648 Tuesday 12th Come with light winds from N.E. Baring the ship on the Eastward took the Cape Baring E by N at 5 P.M. took of shore it came in rain and unpleasant weather. Miaad and latter part fine winds from the N.W. to N.E. the ship on opposite tack working to the N.E. saw 2 ships in the Northward Westward tack Lat 69° 12' N Long 164° 40'

649 Wednesday 13th Come with fresh winds from the N.W. to N.E. the ship working to the N.E. along the Land under all sail. Miaad and latter part light winds from the N.W. and N.E. the ship on opposite tack at 11 A.M. saw none. Chisel a Whaling some fog and rain

650 Thursday 14th Come with light winds from N.W. the ship on the Northward and Eastward tack at 3 P.M. spoke the ship John Berber 11 ships in sight. Miaad and latter part light and and calms some fog Lat 70° 09' N
