

Remarks Log On Board Ship Corinthian

Aug 1868

662 Monday 24th Latter or Mianan and latter part call all hands and lowered the other boats at midnight took him along side at 1 A M commenced to cut at 4 A M finished cutting heard quite a number of whales in the cove at 8 A M started the works

663 Tuesday 25th Come with light airs from the E. N. E. and N. E. at 2 P. M. wind from the E. N. E. light some spoke the ship Florida 3 whaled at 5 P. M. lower 2 Boats for a whale the 1st Bow Boat struck and lost him the Crow came out, shot some Bomb canes but lost the whale the weather raining Mianan part the same latter part light wind from the N. E. and fine weather saw a number of whales but no chance to lower all hands slowing down saw none ship a cutting

664 Wednesday 26th fresh wind from N. N. E. and some fog saw a number of whales but no chance all hands slowing down saw 1 ship take 2 whales 23 ships broke out in sight 6 a Boiling the ship off an a Mut in the Lane near Blossom Shoal Mianan part fresh wind from the N. E. the ship under short sail a Boiling latter part the wind the same and a rain storm

665 Thursday 27th Come with fresh wind from the N. E. and rain the ship laying a back a Boiling saw some ship a cutting the Blossom Shoal in sight or the Lane near the Shoal Mianan & latter fine pleasant weather at 8 A M lower all 5 Boats for a whale with light airs so ends Boats a chasing 27.29

While On Her Northward Cruise 1868

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666 Friday 28th Come with light airs from the E. and S. E. at 4 P. M. the Bow Boat struck a whale and at 2 P. M. took him along side at 3 P. M. commenced to cut at 6 P. M. finished cutting at 7 P. M. the Captains of the Active and Dolphin came on Board and head again Mianan and latter part light wind from N. E. the ship in different tracks at 7 A M commenced to slow down at 9 A M lower 5 Boats for whales so ends a chasing whales the Lane in sight North of Blossom Shoal

667 Saturday 29th Come with light wind from E. to N. E. at 11 P. M. the starboard Boat galley the whale at 4 P. M. came on Board with sad hearts and commenced to slow down at 6 P. M. got supper and set the watch Mianan part light wind from the N. E. the ship laying a back a Boiling latter part fresh wind from the N. E. some rain and fog at 9 A M lower 2 Boats for a whale but no luck the ship Three Brothers got him saw the ship Florida take a whale

668 Sunday 30th Come with light wind from the N. E. some fog and rain saw a few ships a whaling and see a few whales Mianan

lost this day on Blossom shoals with 1100 whale and 20,000 bone - set home 563 whale and 14,696 bone see Starbuck's log 610-611
