

Remarks Part On Board Bk. *Thompson*
11 mo 1864

6 Monday 8th Com with fresh Gales
from the N to N E and heavy
squalls. Midday part laying to
under four main top sail very heavy
squalls. Latter part moderated
some but squalls still heavy at
10 A.M. made some sail steering S E
by compass Lat 38° 09' N
Long 60° 38' W

7 Tuesday 9th Com with light Gales from
N to N W steering S E by compass
Midday and Latter part fresh gales
light Gales from the N to N E and fresh squalls
steering S E and S E by E by compass under
whole main top sail and left fore Lat 36° 46' N
Long 56° 40' W

8 Wednesday 10th Com with light Gales
from N to N E steering S E by E and
fresh squalls with rain. Midday part
light Gales from the N and some rain
2 Bold squalls steering S E by compass
of Mut Latter part light wind from the N
to N E. All hands employed in
Boiling filling the Drib Broom and starting
the Cymourk Lat 35° 41' N
Long 56° 34' W

9 Thursday 11th Com with light wind
Boiling from N steering S E all hands
employed Boiling and Breaking out
for water. Midday and Latter part
light wind from the N and S E the
Ship on the Lane Easton tack at 11
A.M. finish Boiling Lat 34° 40' N
Long 48° 13'

10 Friday 12th Com with light wind from
the S E the Ship on the Lane Easton
tack under all sail fine pleasant
weather. Midday and Latter part light
breezes from the S and S E the Ship on the
Easton tack under all sails Lat 33° 30' N
Long 44° 33' W

11 Saturday 13th Com with light breezes and
Boiling fine weather wind S E to S E the Ship
on the Lane Easton tack the watch employed in
Boiling the Boro Fleet some sail in sight
Midday and Latter part light air
from S E to S E the Ship on the Lane
Easton tack a heavy swell from N W
out for the watch employed in Boiling out
small stores for small stores in the After Hatch
in the

12 Sunday 14th Com with light air from
the S E to S E the Ship on the Lane
tack a heavy swell from the N W the watch
employed in breaking out for small stores
in the After Hatch. Midday part fine
wind from the N steering S E and S E
by E Latter part squalling weather
wind from N to N steering the same
plenty of rain Lat 32° 35' N
Long 43° 49' W

13 Monday 15th Com with fine wind from
the S E some rain squalls steering S E by S
Midday and Latter part light air
and calm plenty of rain saw 3 sails
Lat 31° 37' N
