11 Mo 1869

14 Tuesday 16th Cow with light rain from the S N at 1 P M spoke the Bk Edward Everett N Bedford 12 days out bound around Cape Horn Midway E. Everett and latter part fine rain from the S N steering S E by S fine weather 2 sails in sight Lat 30:25

15 Wednesday 17th Cow with fine rain from S N steering S E by S some Bk in sight Midway and latter part fine weather rain S N steering S E by S by compass the watch empty in various jobs Lat 28:50 N Long 37:55 W

16 Thursday 18th Cow with good weather fine pleasant rain from S N steering S E by E by Sun all sail Midway coiled 2 Men Cow Quins latter part fresh rain from the N to S N of hour with fresh squalls of rain and wind saw some bark steering E by compass no sun

17 Friday 19th Cow with fresh rain from the N to S N steering S E by E and squally weather Midway part rain from the N and squally weather steering S E by S latter part light rain from the S N N saw 3 sails steering S. E and E the watch employed in setting up the Mizzen top mast rigging Lat 25:55 N Long 33:25 W

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18 Saturday 20th Cow with light rain from the S N and N N N steering E by S and S by compass fine pleasant weather Midway and latter part some squalls of rain and rain some thunder and lightning some N and S N and I saw a number of vessels steering different courses Lat 24:50 N Long 32:32 W

19 Sunday 21st Cow with light rain from the S and S N the Bk on the Easton tack a few vessels in sight some squally Midway and latter part fresh rain from the S and S N with fresh squalls the ship on the Easton tack Lat 24:42

20 Monday 22nd Cow with fresh rain from the S and S N with fresh squalls the ship on the Easton tack Midway and latter part the same plenty of rain no sun

21 Tuesday 23rd Cow with light rain from the S E the ship on the S and S N tack plenty of rain and very unpleasant weather Midway the water and latter part the same Lat 24:04

22 Wednesday 24th Cow with rain from S E a cloudy over cast the ship on the S N tack Midway part light rain from S N and S plenty of rain latter part rain the same no rain but a over cast of clouds the watch employed in various jobs of Ships Anty Lat 22:37 N Long 32:15 W
