23 Thursday 25th Corn with light winds

Long 32:46 W

24 Friday 26th Corn with light winds from
1 sail in the land S. E. the ship on the South end
sight Weston took fine pleasant weather
Miaal and latter part fine weather
made a wind S. E. the ship on the Southern tack
New down saw 2 ships steering to the Northward
water under all sail Lat 19:20 N
Long 32:26 W

25 Saturday 27th Corn with fine winds
from the E. S. E. and fine weather the ship
saw 1 ship on the Southern tack saw 1 Brigg steering
in sight Northward Miaal and latter part
fresh breeze from E. S. E. the ship on
the Southern tack some squalls of
rain and wind some sail in sight steering
to the Northward Lat 16:50 N
Long 31:48 W

26 Sunday 28th Corn with fresh winds from
the E. S. E. the ship on the Southern tack
some some squally. Miaal and latter
sail in part the same winds E steering S by
sight E saw 1 ship steering to the Northward
the ship under all sail Lat 14:04 N
Long 30:43 W

28 Tuesday 30th Corn with light trades from
the E steering S by E with cloudy weather
Miaal and latter part the winds
settling E by N E a smoky atmosphere the watch
up Riggin employed in setting up Riggin the head stays
Cornared Lat 8:55 N
Long 28:02 W

29 Wednesday 1st Corn with fine trades
from E. S. E. and a smoky weather steering
settling S by E the watch employed in setting up
up Riggin the Riggin over the Board Miaal part light
and some calm some rain latter part
fine trades from the E and E. S. E.
saw some rain and cloudy weather no sun

30 Thursday 2nd Corn with light winds
or trades from E. S. E. and some squally
with rain steering S by E Miaal and

some squalls saw some ship Lat 5:25 N
Long 26:46 W

31 Friday 3rd Corn with light winds and rain
squalls from the East steering S by N by compass
squalls saw some ship in sight steering to the Southward
saw 1 ship latter part light winds from E to S E
Hearns Bagg latter part winds from the S. E. the
ship on the South and Weston tack
saw 1 Steam Breeze and 2 sailing vessels
some rain squalls Lat 3:25 N Long 27:46 W
