57 Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> Come with changeable wind and weather wind from all points of Boiling the compass at 1 P.M. double reef the top sails but head no wind. Miacca part after wind from the N.W. steering S.W. and by the same fine pleasant weather latter part of Mack wind from the N.W. the ship on the Easton tack fine weather

58 Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> Come with light wind from the S.W. the Bk. on opposite tack Boiling working to the South ward Miacca part light wind from S and N.E. steering broke out S.W. some thunder and lightning in the water. Saw S.W. latter part fresh wind from the N.W. the ship on the Southern tack at 11 Boiling S.W. fresh Boiling

59 Friday 31<sup>st</sup> Come with fresh wind from the N.W. the ship on the S.W. Easton tack Miacca part light air from the N.W. calms latter part light wind from the N.E. steering S.W. by N.W. the watch employed in ship duty and repairing the minding machine when sick of Duty

61 Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> Come with light gales from the N.W. the ship on the Southern tack under gales close reef Main top sail Miacca and latter part fresh gales from the N.W. the ship on the Southern tack and laying under close reef top sails  
Lat 38° 05'

62 Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> Come with light gales from the N.W. the ship on the Southern tack under gales close reef top sails Miacca part light wind from N.W. latter part light strong wind from the N.W. and S.W. steering arrow S.W. by N.W. all hands employed in stowing Oil in the Fore Hatch Between Decks the ship under all sail  
Lat 38° 34' S  
Long 50° 15' W

63 Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> Come with light wind from S.W. to N.W. steering S.W. by N.W. all hands employed in stowing Oil smoky 8 P.M. weather Miacca part at 10 P.M. the wind of S.W. shifted to the S.W. double reef the top sails latter part strong wind from the S.W. the ship on the South and Easton tack with clear weather
