1 mo 1870

88 Saturday 29th Com. with light Gale from N the Ship steering N W saw squalls of rain & Hail Micae part the same latter part strong wind from the N W and rain the Ship on the Northward tack no sun

89 Sunday 30th Com. with fresh wind from the N W and rain at 3 P.M. spoke the Bk. Oahu Mills head saw sperm Whales a few hours before going N W Micae saw latter light winds and some rain from S W and N W the Ship on the Northward tack no sun

90 Monday 31st Com. with fresh wind from the N W and rain and fog the Ship on the Northward tack at 3 P.M. spoke the Bk. Oahu Mills 3 mounds out clean Micae and latter part fresh gales from N and rain the Ship on the Northward tack no sun

91 Tuesday 1st Com. with fresh gales from the N W at 3 P.M. the wind S W steering N N W plenty of rain some Ship in sight Micae part fine breeze from S W steering N N W latter part strong wind from N N W the Ship on the Northward tack Lat 44° 40' Long 78° 13' W

92 Wednesday 2nd Com. with fresh wind from N. N. W the Bk. on the Northward tack Micae and latter part fresh wind from N W and N. N. W the Ship on either tack a cloudy over cast no sun

93 Thursday 3rd Com. with light Gale from the N. N. W the Ship on the Northward tack and cloudy and rainy weather a heavy swell from S W Micae and latter part light wind from the N N W and the Ship on the Northward tack Lat 45° 20' S Long 77° 05' W

94 Friday 4th Com. with fresh wind from the N the Ship by the wind on the Northward tack at 3 P.M. steering N E by compass under all sail Micae part light wind from N. S. W steering N E by N 1/2 N until midnight and the light by until 4 A.M. under sail steering N E by N 1/2 N latter part fresh wind from the N steering N E by N 1/2 N saw 3 Whales at half past 11 A.M. raised the Holland of Honolulu Baring N E distant 15 miles Lat 44° 00' S

95 Saturday 5th Com. with fresh wind from the N the Ship on the Northward tack by the wind 3 Whales in sight Micae part light Gale from the N and rain the Ship having in shore with a heavy swell from S W the Ship on opposite tacks at 2 A.M. the wind from S W the Ship on the Northward tack latter part fresh wind from N S W steering N W Lat 42° 10' S

96 Sunday 6th Com. with light wind from N S W steering N N W and at 6 a heavy swell from S W and fog squalls Micae and latter part light wind and calms at 5 P.M. saw the barbed heads bring E by N 20 miles more sail in sight the Ship steering E N E a heavy swell from the S W Lat 41° 30' S Long 74° 38' W
