Riggins the watch employed in setting up Mizen hoke Riggins Mian and latter part the traics from S.E. to S. and a plenty of rain steering N. by compass under all sail at 10 A.M. the rain cleared up fine pleasant weather Lat 5° 46' S Long 100° 43' W
