Latter part light wind from S. E. and S. S. E steering N. N. W. under all sail Lat 34.08 N Long 178.01 E

183 Monday 2nd July. with rain from S. to S. W. steering N. N. W. by N. and N. N. W. under all sail. Micae part light rain. Some rain in squares the rain. Hay sail N. N. W. and N. N. the ship on the N. and Easton Lat 36.18 N

184 Tuesday 3rd July. with fresh rain from N. W. the ship on the North and E. Now with a close tack some squalls. Middle part strong wind from the North and fresh squalls. Latter part light gales from the North the ship on the Easton tack Lat 34.44 N Long 179.43 E

187 Friday 6th July. with light air and calms. The watch employed in the deck and painting. The over head boats. Micae part the same. Latter part fresh rain from N. E steering N. N. W. by compass Lat 39.19 N

188 Saturday 7th July. with light Gale from N. E steering N. N. W. by compass under Bullock. Double reef top sails. Micae and latter part fresh Gale from E. and E. N. E steering N. N. W. some rain squalls Lat 42.21 N Long 178.19 E

189 Sunday 8th July. with fresh Gale from N. E by E steering N. N. W. and N. N. W. by N. Micae part moderate rain. Latter part fresh rain from the E. N. E and E. thick clouy. over cast some rain steering N. N. W. N. under all sail. Micae P. Blayhorne sick off duty and Francisco Perez sick off duty
