236 Thursday 23rd Calm with fresh wind from the S & the ship on the S.W. tack until 13 P.M. more ship steering N.E. by compass under all sail thick fog
thick fog
Miaac and latter part thick fog the most of the time at 8 A.M. the fog lifted for 1 hour saw ship steering N.W. at 11 A.M. raised the land ice thick fog

237 Friday 24th Calm with light wind from E and S.E. thick fog a heavy swell from the S. Miaac and latter part the same

Saturday 25th Calm with light wind from E and S.E. thick fog a heavy swell from the S. spoke the S. Concordia Miaac thick fog and latter part the same

239 Sunday 26th Calm with light wind from E and S.E. thick fog a heavy swell from the S. sailing with the Concordia thick fog Miaac & latter part the same Lat 64° 00

240 Monday 27th Calm with light air from thick fog the S. N.W. thick fog the most of the time the ship on the N.W. tack Miaac saw the part the same latter part light wind from S and the N.W. the ship on the N.W. tack South Head the fog lifting up at times at 10 A.M. saw S.P. Bay the South Head of Peleber Bay at 11 A.M. spoke the spoke the Horns Bluff of New London

241 Tuesday 28th Calm with light wind from spoke Bk. N.W. and clear in by the land and ice Thigara saw 1 whale at 1 P.M. spoke Bk. Thigara and Thuan Seneca & Roman Miaac and latter part Seneca light air and calm S. Lawrence Island in sight to the East of us Lat 63° 53

242 Wednesday 29th Calm with light air from S to S.W. steering E for the East of S. Lawrence of S. Lawrence Island S. Lawrence Island plant saw a number of vessels going all points of the compass Miaac part light wind from S and the ship steering along the West side of S. Lawrence Island latter part light wind from N at 7 A.M. the Natives came on board from S. Lawrence Island reports & related the season Lat 64° 03

243 Thursday 30th Calm with fresh wind from the N and thick fog the ship on the North and Weston tack at half past noon came up to the spoke Bk. the last ship to the wind waves Miaac Thigara and latter part the same Lat 63° 52

244 Friday 1st Calm with fresh wind from spoke Bk. the S.W. the ship on opposite tack the most Champion of the time foggy weather Miaac & latter part the same thick fog some ice

245 Saturday 2nd Calm with light gales thick fog the ship trying to hold up to the South land ward Miaac & latter part light wind from N thick fog the most of the time
