

Remarks On Board The Dickason

July 4th 1870
 263 Monday 20th Day with light rain from N. W. a thick fog the most of the time all 5 Boats after Malurus at 3 P.M. came on Board with 4 Miaas and Latter part fresh rain from the N at 9 A.M. came with the Bk. Thigana came to the ship working along the Ice to the Bk Thigana Northward saw a few Malurus Lat 68.16

264 Tuesday 21st Day with fresh rain from the N the ship working to the North and Westward along the Ice saw a few Malurus but no wild Miaas and Latter part light rain from N.W. the ship still working along the Ice to the North and Westward some fog Lat 68.43

265 Friday 23rd Day with light air and some ship calms and thick fog at 2 P.M. came on Board the ship on wave outward and Bk. Arctic Miaas part light rain from the S.E. at 1 Malurus 9 P.M. lower 1 boat to tow the ship clear of the Ice thick fog the most of the time Latter part light rain from S.W. clear all 5 Boats in the Ice after Malurus all came on Board for dinner Lat 68.58 N

266 Saturday 23rd Day with fine weather and part Bk. light rain the ship running along the shore Ice to the North at 3 P.M. lower all 5 Boats for Malurus at 5 P.M. the last Boat came on Board saw some Malurus Miaas part at 10 P.M. all the Boats came on board with 16 Malurus all told Latter part fresh rain from S at 8 A.M. lower all 5 boats for Malurus Lat 69.14 N

Beafora Lewis Matter

July 1870
 267 Sunday 24th Day with fresh rain from the S.W. the ship clear the ship in by the edge of the Ice at 3 P.M. the Boats came on Board Miaas and Latter part calms at 8 A.M. lower all 5 Boats a Malurus Lat 69.14 N

268 Monday 25th Day with light rain from the S.W. the ship in the scattering Ice at 4 P.M. the Boats came on Board with Malurus at 8 P.M. spoke the ship on wave Miaas and Latter part light rain from E.N.E. and E.S.E. the ship off and the Ice Lat 69.44

269 Tuesday 26th Day with light rain from the S.W. the ship off and on the Ice some ship in sight Miaas part light rain and calms at 7 A.M. came in a thick fog mine N Lat 69.10

270 Wednesday 27th Day with light rain from the S.W. thick fog at 4 P.M. rain E.S.E. a thick fog Miaas and Latter part light rain from all points of the compass and a thick fog Lat 69.13

271 Thursday 28th Day with light rain from the S.W. and foggy the most of the time at 3 P.M. sent 2 Boats in the Ice to look for Malurus but they lost none of the ship and did not find her until 5 P.M. saw no Malurus Miaas part light rain from E.S.E. and clear the ship steering along the edge of the Ice to the Northward Latter part fresh rain from E at 9 A.M. came in a thick fog Lat 70.30 N
