

Remarks Pass On Board B.S. I. Dickason

July 27th 1870
 272 Tuesday 29th Com. with fresh rain from
 thick fog & a heavy swell from E & thick fog
 the ship on the Southern tack at 7 P.M. the
 rain from N the ship on the Southern
 tack. Miaad and latter part light
 Boiling wind from all points of the compass
 and thick fog the most of the time
 the ship in the ice at 6 A.M. started
 the Cry Noorke Lat 69° 49' N

273 Saturday 30th Com. with light air
 and a thick fog at 3 P.M. rain from
 E & the fog lifted some the ship a Boiling
 and working to the S. Miaad and
 Boiling latter part fresh rain from the S and
 fog the ship off and on the ice noorke
 to the South saw nothing Lat 69° 59' N

274 Sunday 31st Com. with light rain
 from the S and clear the ship working
 to the South along the ice. Miaad part
 fresh Gale from N latter part the same
 saw 1 ship the ship under easy sail running the ice to
 the South and Eastward Lat 68° 59'

275 Monday 1st Com. with fine rain
 from the N and a cloud over east
 40 Boats the ship running the ice to the S and
 40 Boats Eastward at 6 P.M. it came in a
 thick fog took in sail and layed
 to Middle part rain from N latter
 part rain from E & thick fog the most of
 the time the watch employed in slowing
 down Malrus Oil Lat 68° 13'
 Long 171° 48' W

 276 Tuesday 2nd Com. with light rain
 from E at 1 P.M. the fog cleared up
 saw 2 ships Miaad and latter part
 light air and calms all 5 Boats in
 the ice after Malrus Lat 68° 13'
 Long 171° 41'

277 Wednesday 3rd Com. with light air
 21 Boats from all points of compass and
 S. Boat weather at 5 P.M. 3 boats came on Board
 Store. Miaad part at 9 P.M. the rest of
 B. Boat the Boats came on Board 21 Malrus
 Store all told at 10 P.M. set a greater watch
 Latter part fresh rain from E & N E
 some fog and rain at 7 A.M. all 5
 Boats went in the ice after Malrus

278 Thursday 4th Com. with fresh rain
 25 Malrus from N E a cloud over east at 5 P.M.
 B. Boat all the Boats came on Board 25 Malrus
 Store. Miaad and latter part light rain from
 N. Boat the N E some fog and thick weather all the
 Store Boats in the ice after Malrus saw the Brig
 Victory of S. Francisco Lat 68° 14' N

279 Friday 5th Com. with light rain from
 29 Malrus E & N and thick haze weather at 5 P.M.
 up the Boats came on Board with 29 Mal
 Repairing made all sail the ship on the N and E
 B. Boat tack. Miaad and latter part light
 air and calms Lat 68° 30' N
 Long 171° 37' W

280 Saturday 6th Com. with calms at 1 sent
 7 Malrus 3 Boats after Malrus at 7 P.M. 2 Boats
 B. Boat to return with the Carboan Boat
 4 Malrus still. Miaad and latter part rain from E at
 6 A.M. thick fog ship on Eastern tack
