

Arctic Pass On Board Bk. Ch.

Aug 1870

381 Sunday 1st Cow with light rain from E & the ship on the northern tack and Easton tack thick fog. Miac and latter part light rain from E & N E to E S E and thick fog the ship on opposite tack moving to the Eastward

382 Monday 8th Cow with light rain from E & S E the ship on opposite tack moving to the Eastward at 4 P M the fog light up saw 3 ships to the north Miac and latter part light rain from N E and S E the ship on the South and Easton tack at 4 P M saw Cape Eriben Baring & S E at 7 P M calms and fog

383 Tuesday 9th Cow with light air and some fog. Miac and latter part light rain from E to N E the ship standing in for the cape Lat 68.55

384 Wednesday 10th Cow with light rain from N some fog at 6 P M came to 190 Bk. Anchor in 10 fathoms of water and sent a boat on shore the boat pulled Cape Eriben in company Miac at 1 P M the boat came off at 4 P M took the anchor and made sail steering to the North along the land latter part light air and calms saw a number of ships

385 Thursday 11th light rain from N E and East the ship on the northern tack Miac and latter part the same the ship on opposite tack moving to the N E Lat 69.40

Aug 1870

386 Friday 12th Cow with light rain from the N and N E the ship moving to the N E saw a few ships a cloudy overcast Miac and latter part rain the ship on the northern tack latter part fresh Gale from E N E and clear weather from fog or rain no sun

387 Saturday 13th Cow with light Gale from N E and clear weather the ship on the northern tack saw 2 ships Miac and latter part light Gale from N E the ship on opposite tack along the ice Lat 70.36 N Long 164.36 W

388 Sunday 14th Cow with fresh Gale from N E the ship running along the ice to the South light Gale and East wind gaining with the Bk. Champion of Egarstown Miac and latter part fresh Gale from N E the ship in the ice Champion in 17 fathoms of water latter part the last saw 11 ships in sight Lat 70.31 N Long 164.26 W

389 Monday 15th Cow with fresh Gale from the N E the ship in the ice saw 2 coast reef top sail 14 ships in sight Miac and latter part the same Lat 70.06 N

390 Tuesday 16th Cow with fresh Gale from the N E the ship in the ice 2 hours tack from some point of the ice to the other saw 6 ships in sight Miac and latter part moderate rain & the ship moving to the N E a boiling halibut saw a few ships Lat 70.13 N Long 165.40 W
