

Remarks On Board the Mullocky Bk.

Aug 1870

300 Monday 26 Com. with fine wind from NE all of the Boats down after Males but no chance at 3 P.M. all came on board a number saw a number of ships cutting at 4 P.M. of ships Point Barrow distant 3 Leagues Males cutting and latter part light Gale

301 Tuesday 27 Com. with light Gale from E see a few to NE some snow in equalled saw a few Males Males and Loured for them but no Bent a chance Males part fresh Gale from NE Gore sail the ship working to the North at 5 A.M. split the Old Gore sail and Bent a Nothy latter part weather the same saw no Males

302 Wednesday 28 Com. with light Gale from NE Almir at 2 P.M. saw the Bk. Almir and Egerton's above by signal set in distress steered down to her found her above by the Males and latter part light Gale and clear Point Barrow Barrow by compass E by S at 11 A.M. Hibornie saw the ship Hibornie set Beacon signal above set in distress suppose above by the Ice and saw 4 or 5 ships in company

304 Thursday 29 Com. with fresh Gale from NE the ship off and on the Ice see nothing Males and latter part fresh wind from NE and a thick fog or snow the most of the time the ship under short sail some ice scattering passed at 11 A.M. spoke the Bk. Roman 4 Males saw a few ships and none Males

300 Tuesday 30 Com. with light wind from NE a thick fog frozen into snow very cold at 3 P.M. lower 3 boats for a Males but did not see him again Males part fine saw a number from the NE and good weather latter part the same saw a number of Males lower a number of times but no luck saw none ship take a Males out of 22 ships whaling

306 Wednesday 31 Com. with fine wind and the Bow good weather at 3 P.M. lower all 5 Boats Boat got for Males the Bow Boat struck and at 6 P.M. took him along side at 7 commenced to cut at 9 P.M. finished and set the watch Males and latter part fine weather at 10 A.M. lower 2 Boats but did not see the Males again

307 Thursday 1 Com. with light wind from NE and fog the ship laying north her head yards aback Males part and latter part light wind from NE and thick fog the ship under all sail working to the N

308 Friday 2 Com. with light wind from the N Harbored at 2 P.M. the fog cleared off saw Males Boat # lower all 5 Boats the Harbored Boat got St. Bar none and the Harbored Bow Boat got Boat # none Males part at 1 A.M. finish cutting and set the watch latter part steering to the South and Males along the Eastern Ice saw a few Males and quite a number of ships cutting but see no chance to get any
