309 Saturday 3rd Comm. with light rain from
Boiling N. N. E. some fog saw but few Whales but
see a good many of ships cutting at 1 P.M.
and ships started the Crydourts. Miacaw part the
cata. rain from N. N. E. latter part some
Whale fog light rain from N. E. 3 Boats across
after Males no sun

310 Sunday 4th Comm. with light rain from
Boiling the 3rd some rain and fog 3 Boats chasing
the Males no luck at 6 P.M. came on Board
Killed a thick fog Miacaw part and latter part
the same some fog at 10 A.M. the fog lifted
and 3 Boats for Whales in the Ice

311 Monday 5th Comm. with light rain from N. E.
Boiling and the 3 boats in the Ice at 4 P.M. low
15 ships the other two boats but no luck at 7 P.M. was
a cutting the Boats came on Board the Harbour
Boat struck and Boat rose and
Harbour Arise from him Miacaw and latter part
lost a light rain from N. E. and fine weather at
Whale # 5 A.M. called all hands and lowered for
Whales all 5 Boats Lat. 71.32

312 Tuesday 6th Comm. with light rain
10 ships from N. E. and fine weather all 5 Boats
a cutting above after Males no luck at 7 P.M.
17 a Boiling all came on Board it came in a thick
fog Miacaw and latter part light rain
from the N. E. some fog at 4 A.M. the
Mast Boat low and fastened and
Killed a Whale with some of Pierce's Guns
at 7 A.M. took him along side at 8 A.M.
commenced to cut him at 10 A.M. finished

313 Wednesday 7th Comm. with light rain
from the E. N. E. steering to the South and
Met. rain at 5 P.M. low all 5 Boats
for Whales no luck at dark came on
Board Miacaw and latter part light rain
from E. and S. E. all hands employed in storing
Oil in Main Hatch and chasing Whales Lat 71.31
Long 154.30

314 Thursday 8th Comm. with fine weather rain
saw 8 ships from S. E. some ships of rain all hands employ
cutting in storing Oil in Main Hatch Miacaw part
light rain from the N. the ship on the South
back along by the Edge of the Ice latter
part the same Lat 71.32

315 Friday 9th Comm. with light rain from
W. N. W. and N. N. the ship on the S. and
Met. a thick Miacaw part light rain
from N. E. the ship laying a back on different
tacks at 5 A.M. a Whale and lowered 2
Harbour Boats the Harbour Boat struck latter
Boat part fresh rain from N. E. at 7 A.M. took
the Whale along side at 9 A.M. commenced
to cut him so was this day a cutting a
large Whale Lat 71.39 N

316 Saturday 10th Comm. with light fresh rain
from N. E. steering S. N. a cutting at 2 P.M.
Piercing quick cutting at 5 P.M. into Port Barrow
and the ribs of the Hiburnia being E. S. E.
Miacaw and latter part fresh rain
from E. and N. E. the ship laying a back
on opposite tacks Lat 71.37
