

Remarks Pass On Board Ship No.

Sept 1870

326 Tuesday 20th Com. with fine rain from NE a thick overcast steering S under all sail at 3 P.M. raised Mailed Number and lowered all 5 Boats at 3 P.M. came off Mailed on Board the Concordia took rove along side all 4 Ships a Mailing at 4 P.M. took in sail for the Night Mailed and latter part fine rain from the E steering S by N all 4 Ships in company no sun

327 Wednesday 21st Com. with fine rain from the NE steering S by N and Mailed saw 1 Whale going quick to the N at 11 A.M. all 4 Ships came to gather and heard a gun Mailed and latter part fine rain from the E steering N at 11 A.M. raised Herold Delana bar by compass N distant 10 leagues Lat 41.23

328 Thursday 22nd Com. with light gales from S quite the E NE at 2 P.M. raised quite a Number of Mailed our 4 Boats but bad luck and some bad management at 5 P.M. took the Boats up the Concordia caught too Mailed and latter part light rain from NE and a heavy swell from the E the ship on short looks the Delana bar by compass N distant 10 to 26 Miles no sun

329 Friday 23rd Com. with light rain from NE the ship under all sail working to the NE saw the Roman take a Whale to the NE of us Mailed and latter part the same the Mary & Roman Mailed to the NE of us the Delana in sight bar by N by N

330 Saturday 24th Com. with light rain from Roman NE to E the ship under all sail working to the rain road at 1 P.M. the Roman Mailed took a Whale at 3 P.M. lowered 5 Boats for Mailed to the rain road at 4 P.M. the Mary took rove at 6 P.M. the Boats the E.D. all came on Board no luck and a calm #5 Mailed part fine rain from the NE caught 2 saw 2 Ships to the NE whaling latter part Mailed light rain from NE and a heavy swell from the E NE the Delana bar by N by N no sun

331 Sunday 25th Com. with fine rain from employed the NE employed in cutting and the Starboard in cutting Boat a row a Mailing at 3 P.M. finished cutting rove Mailed at 5 P.M. commenced to cut 88 Bore the other Mailed part at 11 P.M. finished Boat Mailed cutting and set the watch latter part light gales saw 4 Ships the Delana bar by N by compass the Bk. Roman whaling NE of us saw 1 Whale no sun

332 Monday 26th Com. with strong rain from the Roman NE the ship trying to work to the NE saw took a Whale the Roman took a Whale NE 10 Miles the Delana bar by N distant 10 Miles Mailed 2 Mailed and latter part fine weather rain from the NE at 8 A.M. the Starboard Boat fastened Boat got a Whale at 9 A.M. took him along side Boat at 10 A.M. commenced to cut and lowered 4 Ships 2 Boats the Bow & the quarter Boats in sight at 11 A.M. lowered the Starboard Boat and the Bow Boat the Starboard Boat struck a Whale the Bow & the Bow Boat got home by him after came on Board the Delana bar by N by N rain East
