Oct 1890

363 Monday 28th Nov. with light gales from the N.E. and squalls of wind and rain stopping E by compass. Miacos part light gales from the E. N. E. the ship on the Southern tack some rain and cloudy weather. Latter part rain & the weather the same. Ship on the Southern tack the same no sun

364 Saturday 29th Nov. with fresh rain from the E. the ship on the Southern tack. Scraping thick cloudy weather. Miacos part the same. Latter part clear weather. Rain the same. The watch employed in Scraping Bone and Boiling up the stores. Lat 35° 30' Long 162° 14' W

365 Sunday 30th Nov. with fresh wind from the E. the ship on the Southern tack pleasant weather. Miacos and Latter part the same. See nothing. Lat 33° 44' N Long 161° 59' W

366 Monday 31st Nov. with light gales from the E. the ship on the Southern tack some squalls. Miacos and Latter part fresh gales from the E. the ship on the Southern tack at 4 P.M. double reef the top sail and hauled the 9th the watch employed in scraping Bone. Lat 32° 00' N Long 161° 54' W

367 Tuesday 1st Dec. with fresh gales from the E. N. E. by compass the ship on the Southern tack. Miacos and Latter part the same. Employed in scraping Bone saw some Bk on the Southern tack. Lat 30° 43' N Long 160° 40' W

365 Wednesday 2nd Dec. with light gales from the E. N. E. the ship on the Southern and Eastern tack saw some sail. Miacos and Latter part fresh rain from the E. N. E. the ship on the Southern tack all hands employed in washing Bone. Lat 29° 08' N Long 160° 00' W

366 Thursday 3rd Dec. with fresh rain from the E. N. E. the ship on the Southern tack all hands employed in washing Bone. Miacos and Latter part the same. some rain squalls. Lat 27° 38' N Long 159° 18' W

367 Friday 4th Dec. with light gales from the E. N. E. the ship on the Southern and Eastern tack at 6 P.M. finish washing Bone. Miacos and Latter part fresh rain from E. N. E. and fresh squalls with rain and wind the ship on the South tack. Lat 26° 11' N Long 158° 42' W

368 Saturday 5th Dec. with light gales from the E. N. E. the ship on the Southern tack some fresh rain squalls. Miacos and Latter part fresh gales from the E. and rain some heavy squalls of wind and rain.

369 Sunday 6th Dec. with fresh gales from the E. the ship on the Southern tack fresh squalls with rain the ship under to close reef top sails. Miacos part fresh gales from the E. at 9 P.M. took in a close reef fore top sail. Latter part fresh gales with squalls from the E. the ship on the Southern tack under 2 close reef top sails.
