- 424 Friday 30th Com. with light rain from the E steering S by E and some rain squalls. Mian and latter part light rain from the rain S. S. W and S. S. E steering S by compass plenty of rain and unpleasant no sun
- 425 Saturday 31st Com. with light rain from the S. S. W and S. S. E steering S plenty of rain Mian part light rain from the S the ship by the wind heading E under easy sail at 1 A.M. in the rain (Watch head a fresh gale of rain and rain latter part plenty of rain the rain North steering S by W at 11 A.M. the rain blew up the ship under all sail this is the last day of 1870. Lat 13.00 S Long 154.16 W
- 426 Sunday 1st of 1871 Com. with light rain from the S. S. E steering S by S under all sail pleasant weather Mian and latter part fine rain from E. S. E a pleasant weather steering S by S saw nothing Lat 14.35 S Long 155.20 W

- 431 Friday 6th Com. with light rain from the S. S. E the ship off and on 50 Boats at 7 P.M. all of the Boats were on Board at 9 P.M. made sail steering S by E Mian and latter part light rain Lat 19.38 S Long 159.57 W
- 432 Saturday 7th Com. with light rain from the S. S. E steering S by S Mian and latter part light rain from the S. S. E some thin rain squalls at 9 A.M. the Island of Rotonga bearing S by E Lat 21.06 S Long 160.08 W
- 433 Sunday 8th Com. with light rain from the E. N. E the ship off the South and Eastern tack the land in sight bearing E saw 1 Ship Mian part fine rain steering S. S. E by compass latter part light rain from the S. S. E the ship on the Eastern tack by the wind the ship under all sail Lat 22.48 S Long 159.16 W
