- 434 Tuesday 10th Cow. with light airs from the N. E. and steering E. S. E. the watch Repairing employed in Repairing the Fore top sail Mian and Latter part light airs from the S. the ship on the Eastern tack. Lat 23° 30' S Long 158° 39' W
- 435 Wednesday 11th Cow. with light winds from Repairing the E. S. E. the ship on the Southern tack the Fore top watch employed in Repairing the Fore top sail Mian and Latter part fine winds from the E. S. E. the ship on the Southern tack at 6 A. - 438 Saturday 14th Cow. with fresh winds from the E. S. E. the ship on the Southern tack some passing Repairing rain squalls Mian and Latter part fresh winds from the E. S.
