 3 A.M. came in a thick fog at 11 P.M. the fog

 breeze from S. E. and south wind foggy at 6 A.M. commenced
 Boiling at 9 A.M. spoke ship Florida some fog
- 626 Friday 21st Com. with fresh rain from S. E. 3 P.M.
 finish Boiling Miaale part light rain from S. E.
 Boiling and fog a heavy swell from S. latter part the same
- 627 Saturday 22nd Com. with light rain from S. and thick
 foggy the most of the time the ship lying with her
 heads yards aback Miaale part at 9 P.M. the fog cleared
 sawing made all sail at 1 A.M. the fog ship under
 in 30 fathoms again pointed and S. E. sail 11 ships latter part
 the same thick fog almost a rain

 N. E. & N. W. & Malus the Dec Miaale and latter
 light rain from E. & E. and foggy at 8 P.M. spoke the
 ship Florida Boiling & Roman & Miaale thick
