

Remarks on board Ship Corinthia bound

Sunday Sept 14th

Came in with a strong breeze from the N.W. pleasant steering S. by W. per compass two points variation W. Middle part light airs pleasant steering by the wind under short sail at latter part a moderate breeze from N.W. pleasant saw the Land to the southward of the Cape of good hope kept off for the Cape all sail set by Enos the Day

Monday Sept 15th

Came in with a moderate breeze from the N.W. pleasant steering for Simons Bay all sail set at 6 took Pilot and 8 o'clock came to an anchor in Simons Bay in 8 fathoms water and gave the ship 15 fathoms of chain the other anchor off the bows all ready for letting go double reefed the top sails and furled the stem middle part light airs pleasant latter part the same came in Simons Bay to nail on our sheathing and copper which was coming off fast outside hired two Carpenters from the shore to put it on hands Employed healing the ship sending down top gallant mast rigged in the rig bit boom

Tuesday Sept 16th

Came in with a light breeze from the N.W. pleasant Employed in various jobs Middle part light airs latter part the same Carpenters Employed on the ship hands Employed in various jobs so Enos

Wednesday Sept 17th

Came in with light airs from S.W. pleasant Laying at single anchor hands Employed in Ships duty Middle part light airs latter part a light breeze from the N.W. pleasant hands Employed in various jobs so Enos

Thursday Sept 18th

Began with a moderate breeze from the N.W. pleasant Laying at single anchor Employed getting stuff off from the shore and getting ship ready for sea Middle part a fresh breeze from the southward with rain latter part a fresh breeze from the N.W. pleasant commenced getting the anchor and at 9 at 10 took up to the bows made sail and with all hands on board proceeded to sea at 10 clear of the Bay got the anchor on the bows stowed chairs got ship ready for sea and so Enos the Day steering S.

Friday Sept 19th

Commenced with a stiff breeze from the N.W. with squalls of rain and wind steering S. by E all sail set Middle part blowing fresh double reefed the top sail latter part more moderate

steering S. by E. under double reefed top sails fit and main sail saw one ship so Enos the Day
